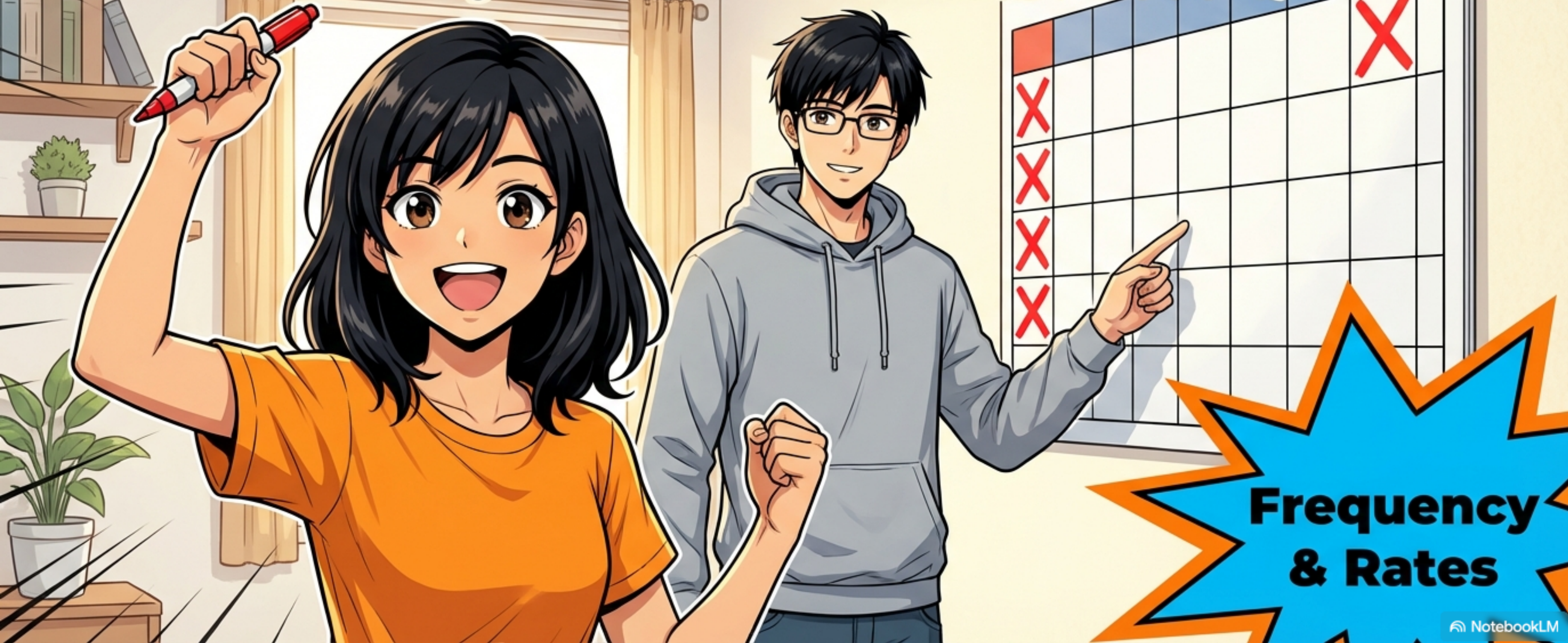

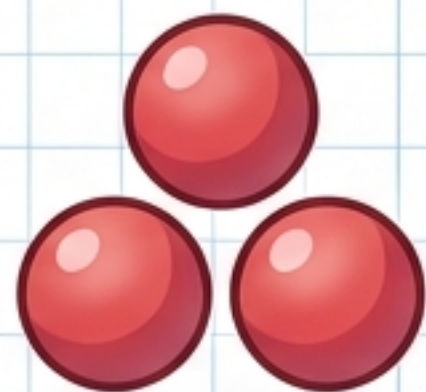
Defining the Rate

Tokidoki
(Sometimes)?

1-shuukan **NI** 1-kai
(1/week)!

Words like 'Sometimes' are vague. To be precise, we use a **rate**. The particle **NI** creates this 'Per' relationship.

The 'NI' is the Divider (/)



3-kai

Think of 'NI' as the slash symbol (/) or the word 'Per'. It divides the time bucket.

[NI] PER



1-kagetsu

3 times PER (NI) Month

**1-nichi
(Day)**

We usually
measure frequency
in these four units.
Memorize these
words first!



**1-kagetsu
(Month)**



**1-shuukan
(Week)**



**1-nen
(Year)**



Don't do this!

1-shuukan
NO 3-kai...



1-SHUUKAN
NO 3-KAI

Don't use '**NO**'!
'NO' connects nouns.
For rates, you
MUST use '**NI**'!

○ 1-shuukan NI 3-kai

Summary Cheat Sheet

Structure: [Period] ni [Count] kai

Meaning: Frequency / Rate (Per)

Key Example: 1-nichi ni 3-kai
(3 times a day)

Rule: Never use “NO” for rates!
