

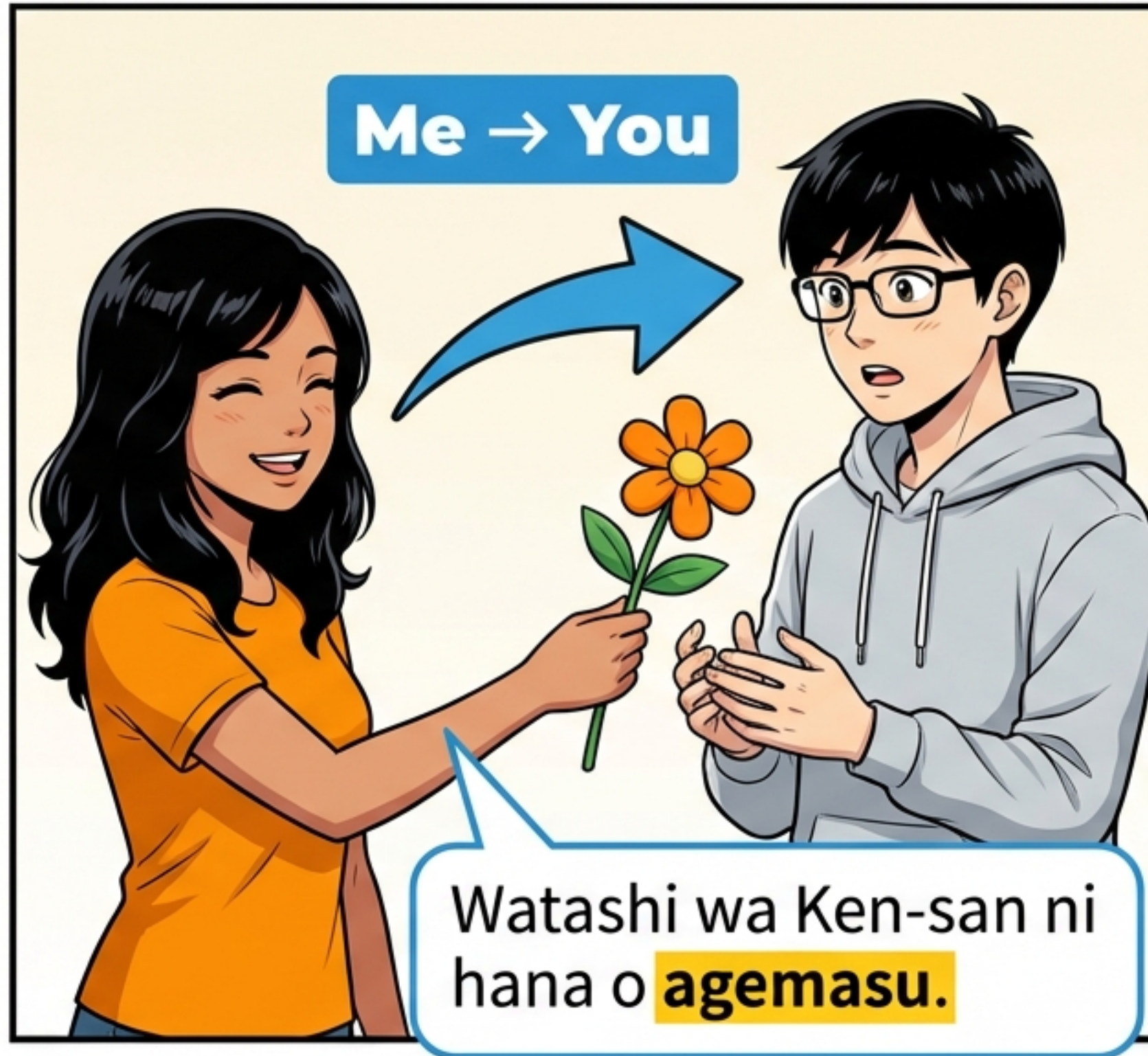

The Arrow Goes **OUT** or **SIDEWAYS.**



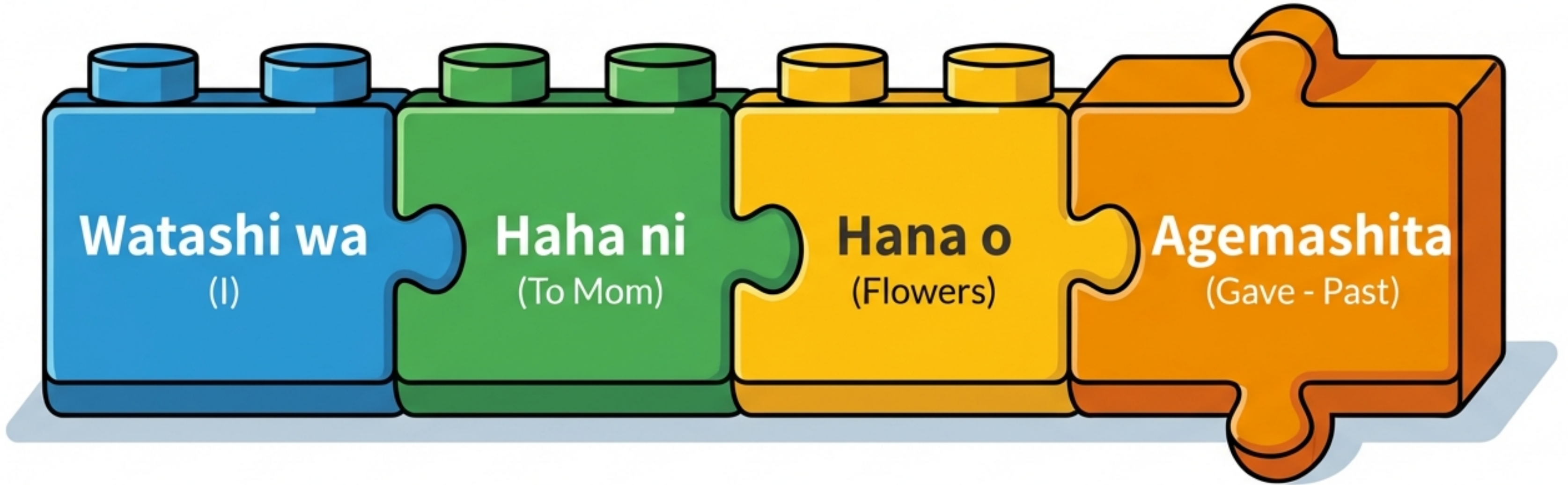
# Aim at the Receiver (NI)!



- **Watashi** wa  
(Giver)
- Tomodachi **NI**  
(Receiver)
- **Purezento** o  
(Object)
- **Agemasu**  
(Action)



# Sentence Build: The Past Tense



私は母に花をあげました。

(I gave flowers to my mother.)





**Stop!**  
**Never say**  
**"Watashi NI**  
**Agemasu"!**

## **Raya's Hack:**

You can **NEVER** use  
**"Agemasu"** if the  
receiver is **YOU**.

'Agemasu' pushes  
away.

If **someone** gives to  
**YOU**, that is a  
different verb!



# GAME OVER! Common Mistake

Ken-san wa  
watashi ni  
agemashita!

BUZZER

Wrong verb!  
If **I** gave it to  
**you**, use  
**'Kuremashita'**.  
We'll learn  
that next!

✖ ケンさんは私にあげました  
(Ken gave to me [INCORECT VERB])



# AGEMASU (To Give)



- ➡ **Meaning:** To give (Outward)
- ➡ **Direction:** Me → Others / Others → Others
- ➡ **Structure:** [Giver] **wa** [Receiver] **ni**  
[Object] **o** agemasu.



**WARNING:** DO NOT use when Receiver is 'Watashi' (Me).
