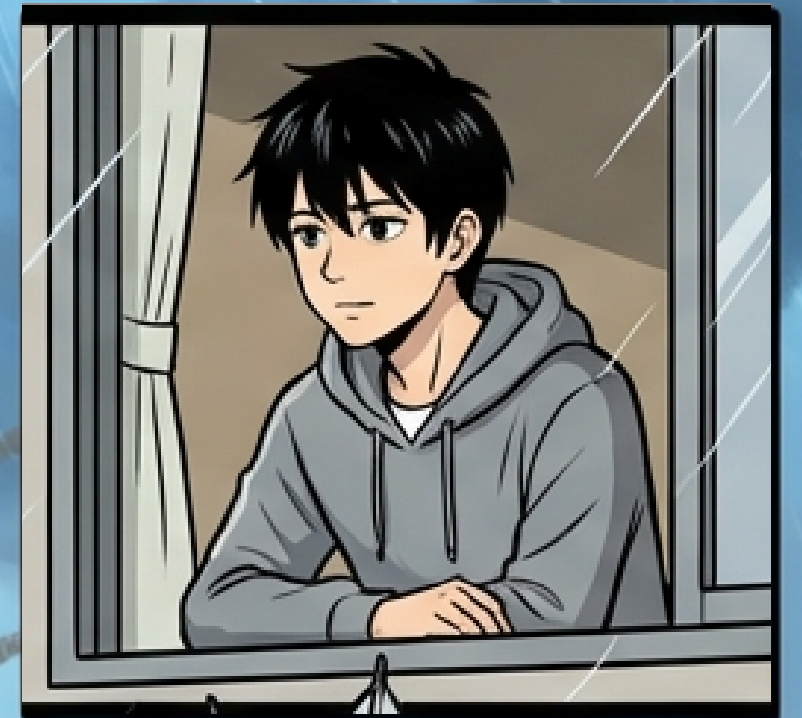

Ordinary Logic



Rain... I stay home.
(Ame da kara, ikimasen)



Rain... DEMO... I GO!
(Ame demo, ikimasu)



****Even if** A happens, B doesn't change!**

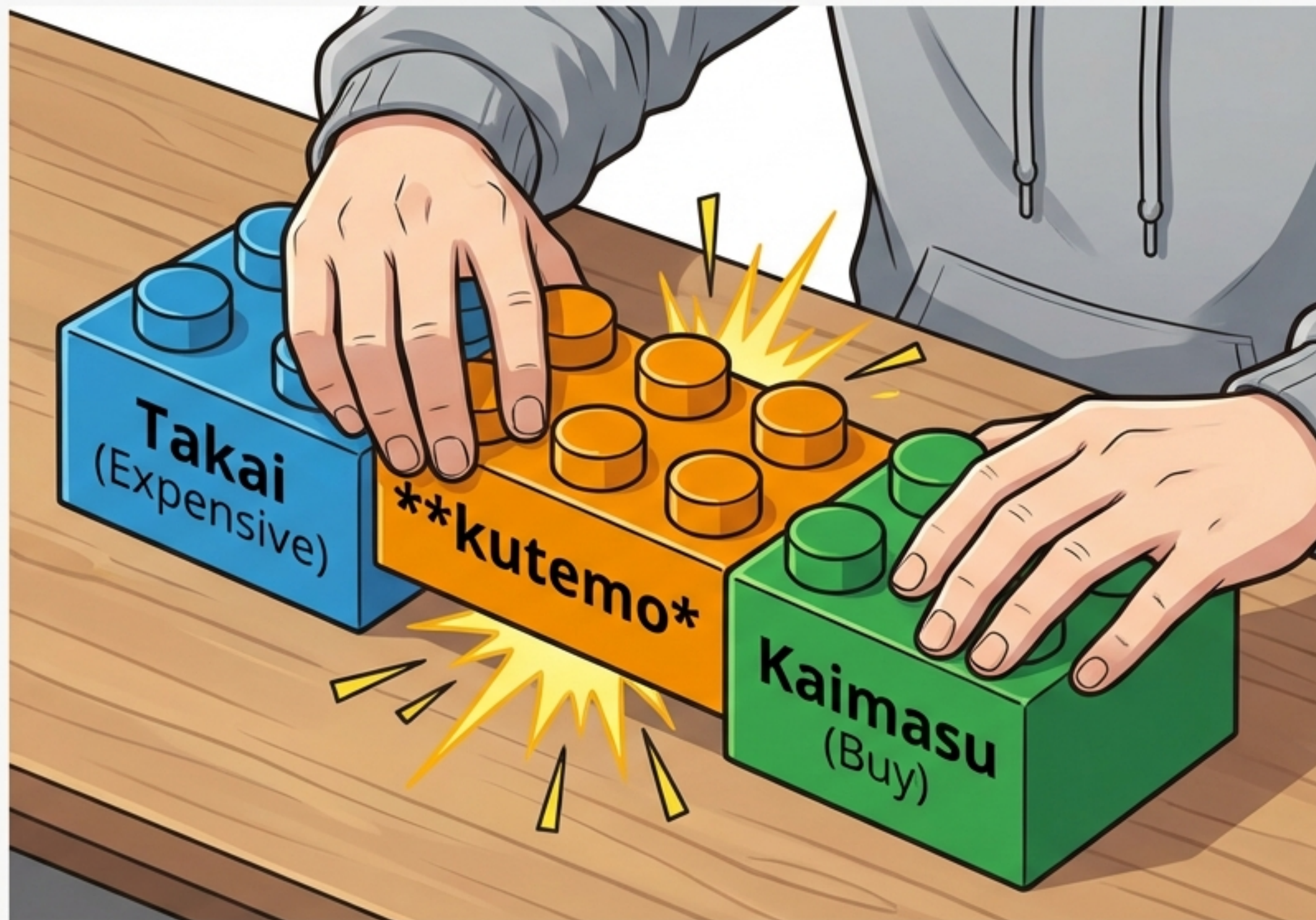


Te-form + MO

Tabete + mo → Tabetemo
(Even if I eat)

Yasukute + mo → Yasukutemo
(Even if it's cheap)

Exception:
Noun/Na-adj
→ **DE** + **MO**



高くても、買います。
(Even if it is expensive, I will buy it.)

Raya's Hack: The 'Demo' Switch

**Nouns & Na-Adjectives
→ DEMO**



Watch out! Nouns and Na-adjectives don't use 'Temo'. They use 'Demo'. It sounds like the word 'Demo' (But), so it's easy to remember!

1. **Ame demo** (Even if rain – Noun)
2. **Suki demo** (Even if I like it – Na-adj)
