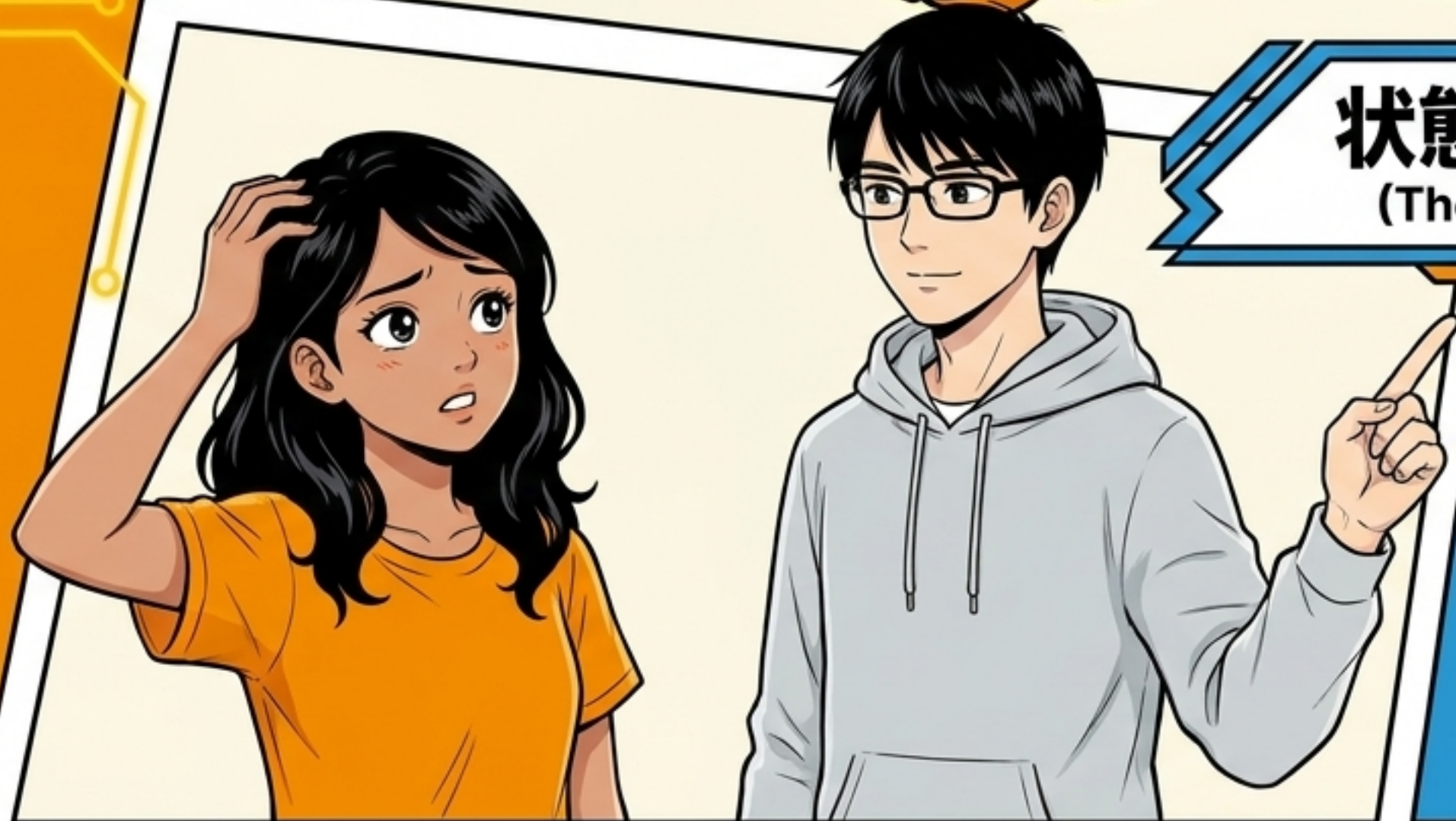


Vない / いい Adj + とき な Adj + とき (When...)

(The Timing of States & Negation)

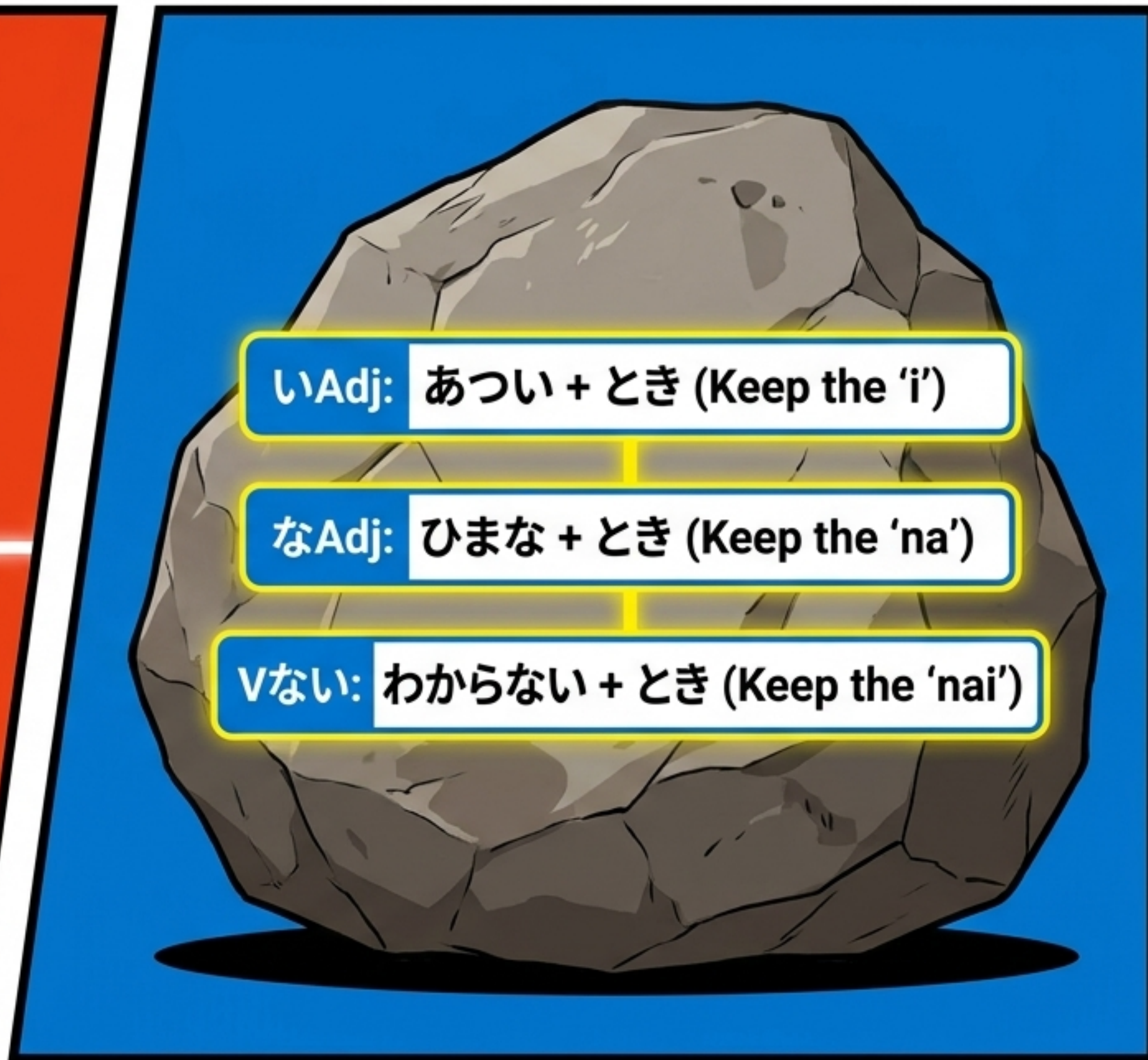


「どんなとき」に何を？ (When doing what?)

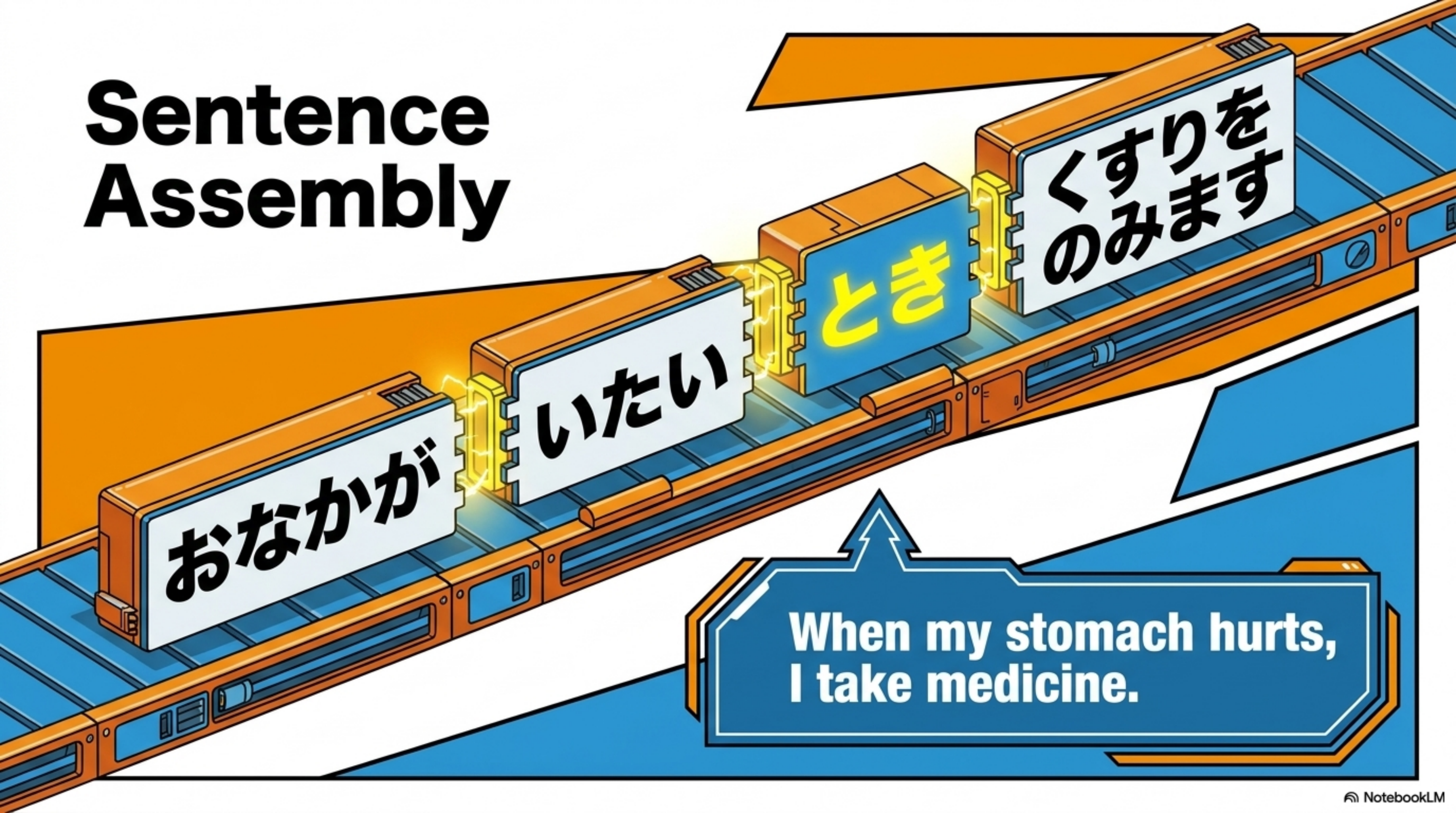


Previous lessons covered action movements like 'When I go'.
Now let's master states (Adjectives) and negative timing (When I don't...)!

States are STILL. Actions are ALIVE.



Sentence Assembly



おなかが

いたい

とき

くすりを
のみます

When my stomach hurts,
I take medicine.

Raya's Hack

Does it have a heartbeat?

If it's a state (Adjective) or a negative (Vない)—it has no pulse! It sits still.

Just add **とき** directly!
(Don't forget 'na' for na-adj).

Don't do this!

「ひまとき！」



Stop!
“Hima” is a
Na-Adjective.
Never forget
the “na”!

Cheat Sheet: The "とき" Rules

いAdj : そのまま + とき
(わかい とき)

なAdj : な + とき
(しずかな とき)

Vない : そのまま + とき
(たべない とき)
