

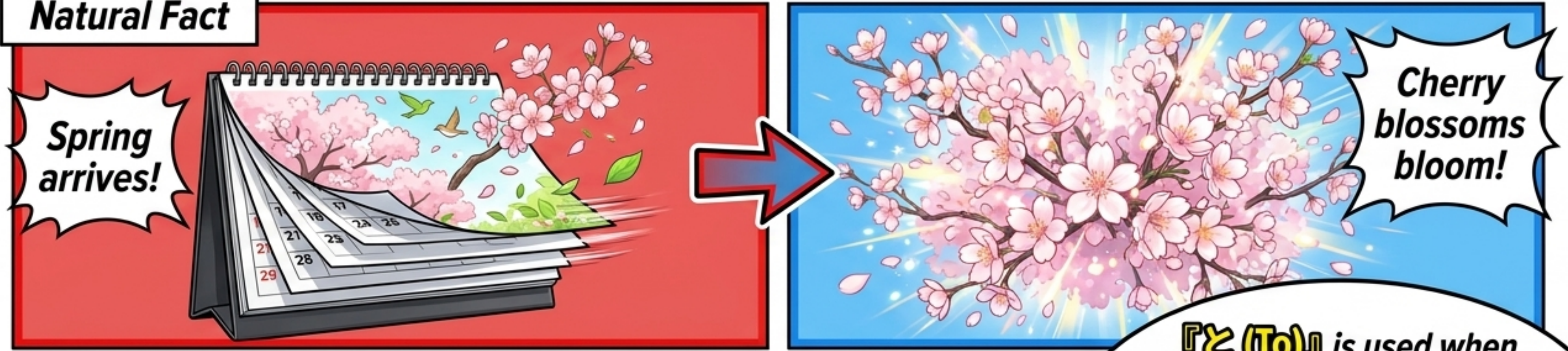

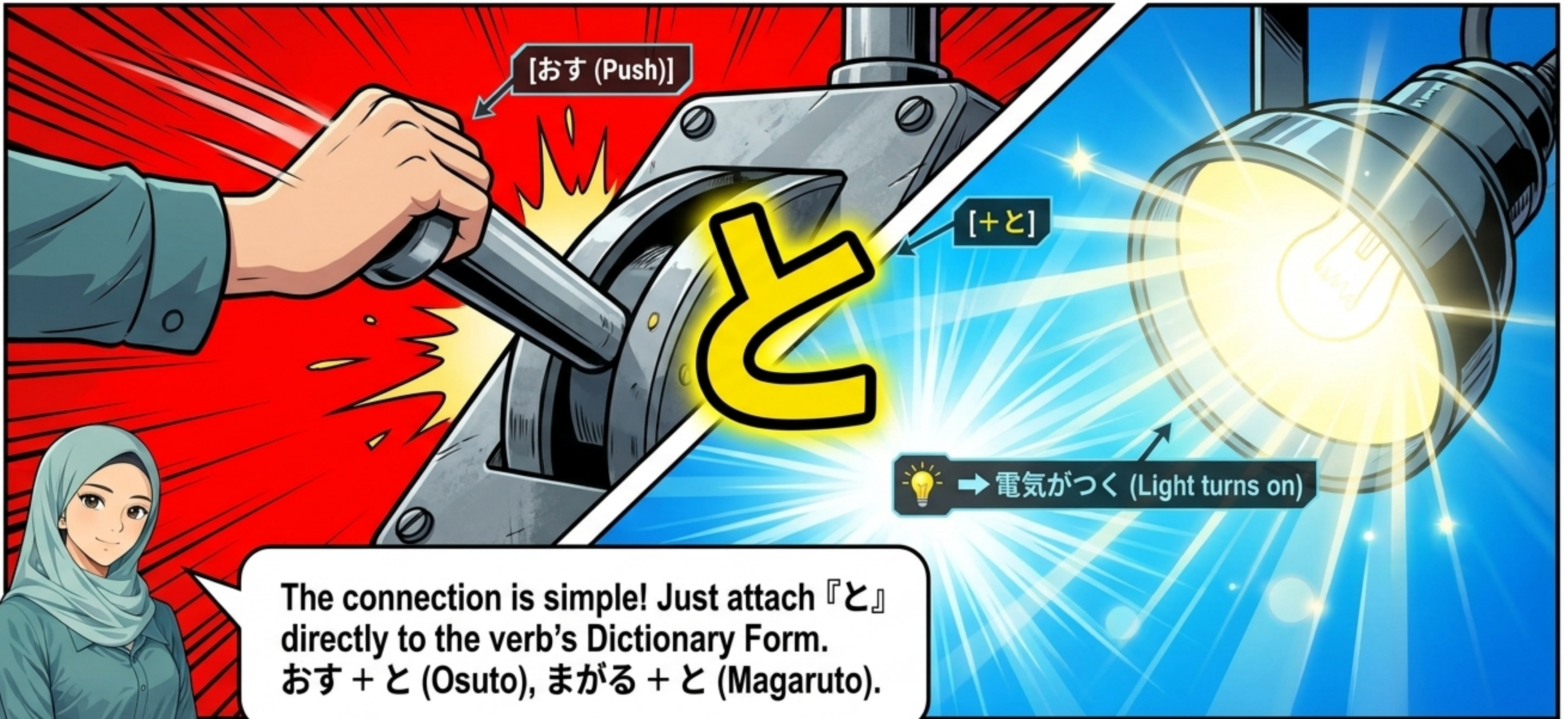

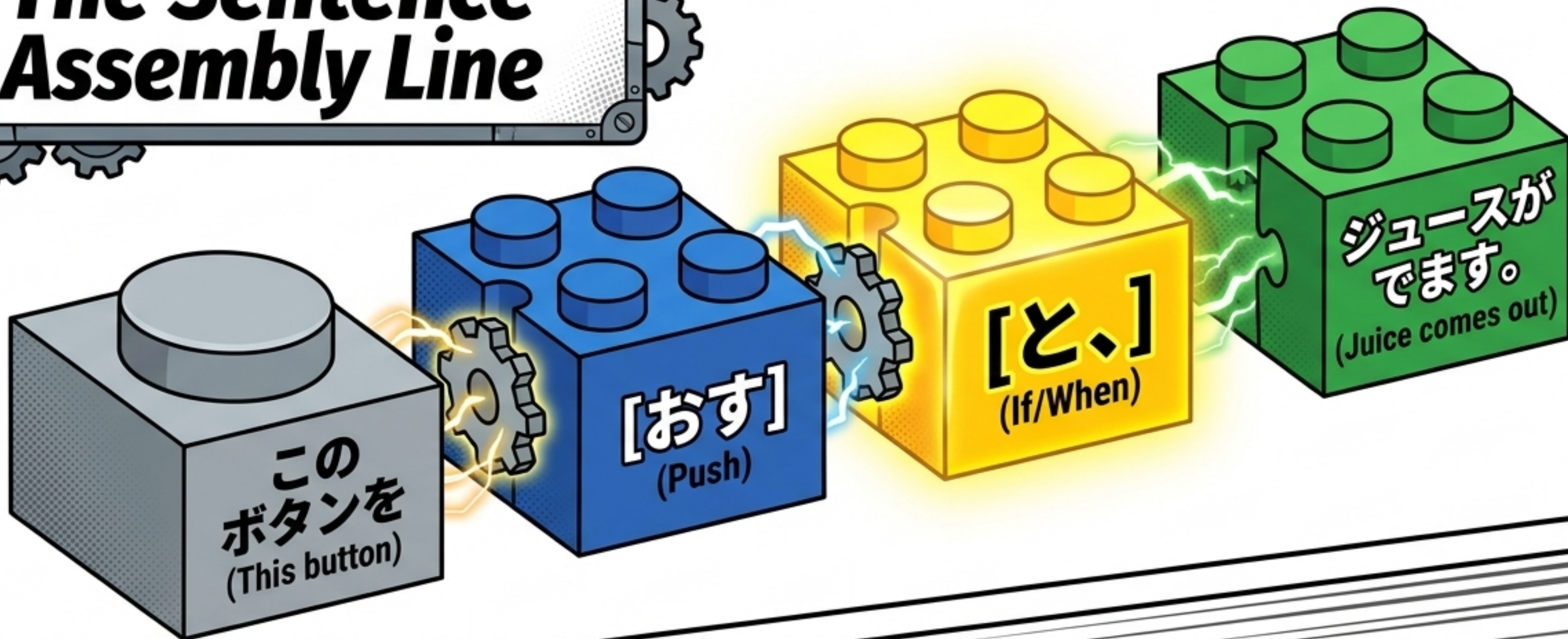

When do you use it?  
Memorize these three:  
Operating machines,  
giving street directions,  
and natural facts.  
If it doesn't fit here,  
don't use 『と』!

# The Danger Zone: Don't do this!

えきにつくと、  
でんわして!

**×えきにつくと、  
でんわして  
ください**

**Stop!**  
You can NEVER use 『と』 with requests (~てください) or invitations (~ましょう). It only works for automatic results!

# The Synthesis Cheat Sheet



<b>Structure:</b>	<b>[Verb Dict Form] + と</b>
<b>Meaning:</b>	<b>If / When (Automatic consequence)</b>
<b>Perfect for:</b> ✓	<b>Machines, Directions, Nature</b>
<b>Danger:</b> ✗	<b>Cannot use with requests or invitations</b>

**Push the button, get the result!  
That is the power of 『と』.**
