The Concept: Existence vs. Continuity



The state has ended.

*Mada (まだ) proves
the 'diamond' is still
in the box!*



**The state is STILL
happening or there is
STILL MORE to come.**

The “Mada” Progress Bar



まだ + Verb
(Positive / ~te iru)



The action or state hasn't finished loading yet. It is still going!

Sentence Build: The Assembly Line

Glue

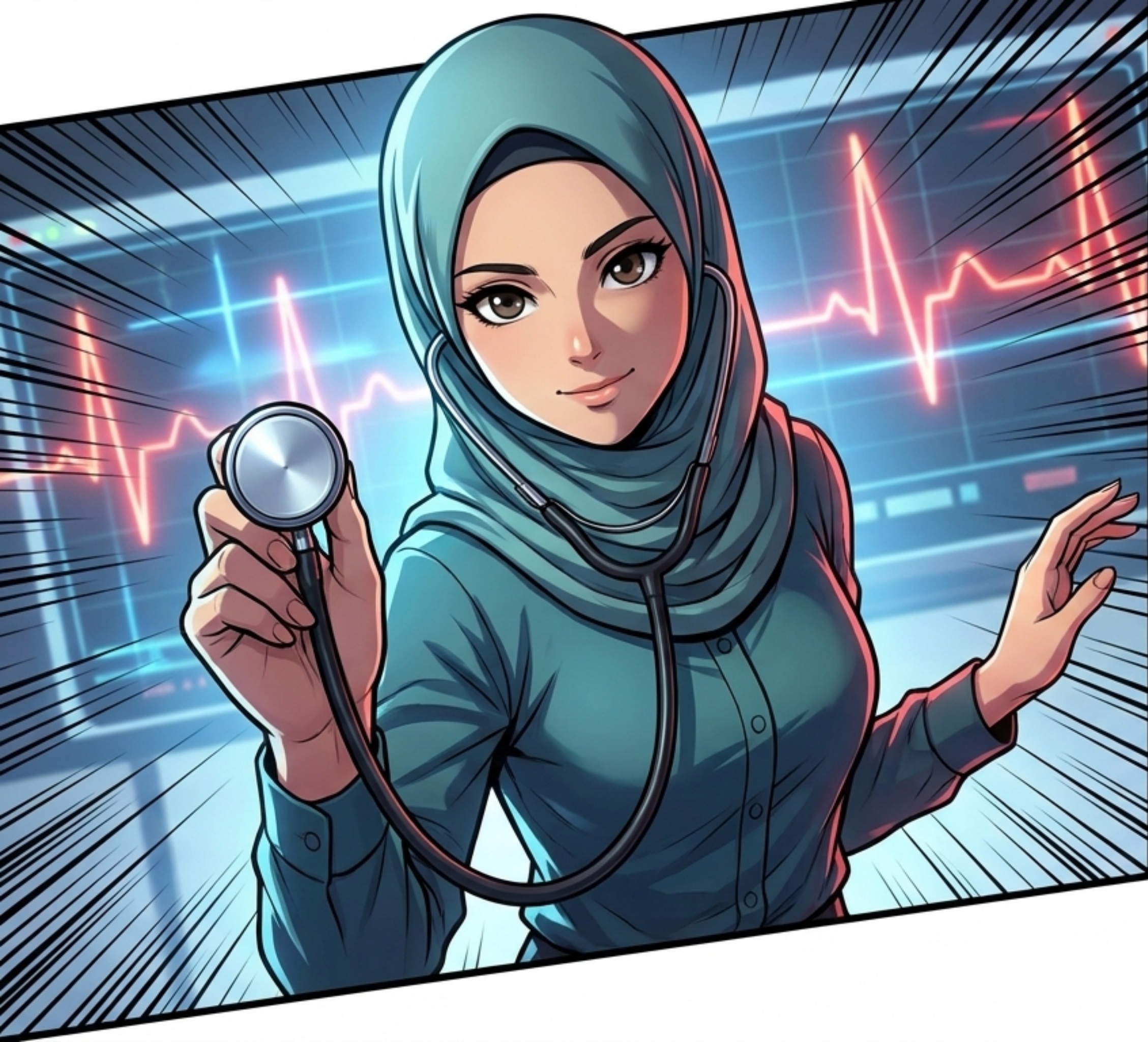
【まだ】

(Rain)

あめが まだ ふっています。
(It is still raining.)

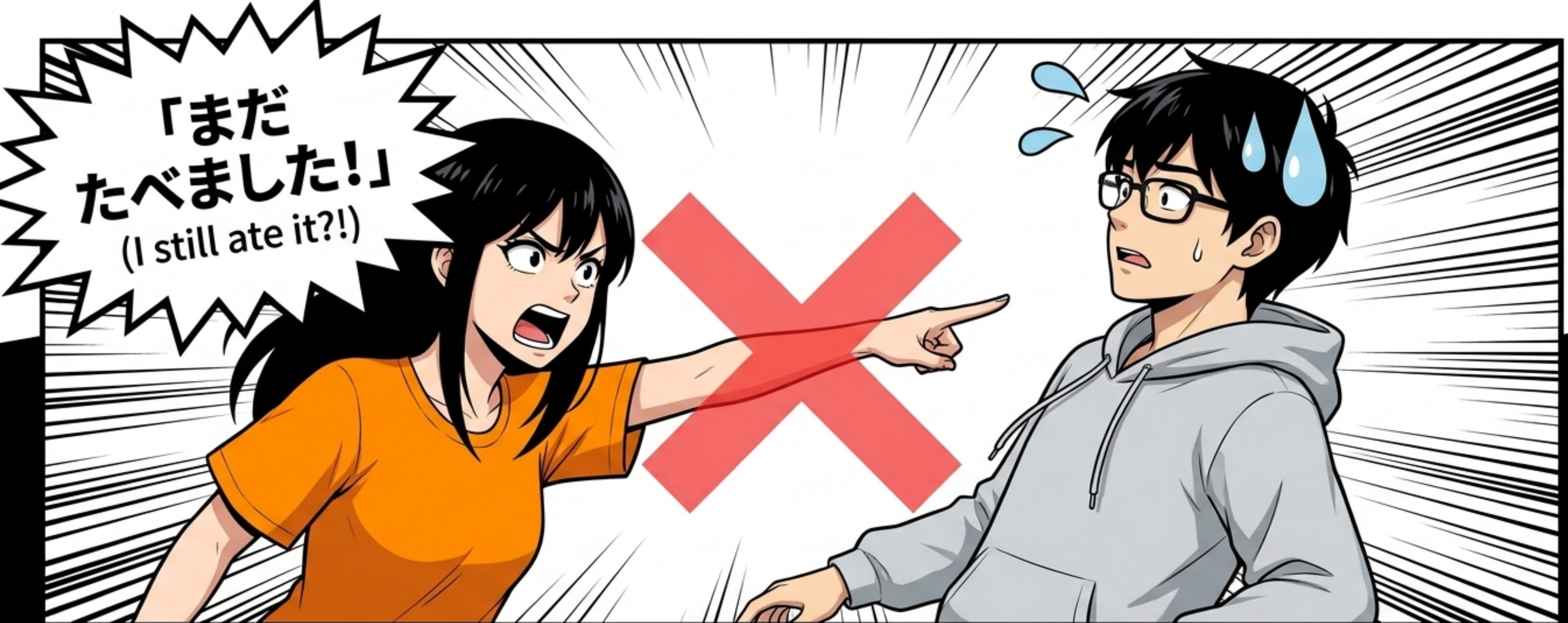


Raya's Hack: Does it have a heartbeat?

まだ + Amount + あります

Treat leftover amounts like a pulse! If there are still cookies left on the plate, the supply is **“still alive.”**

- (e.g., まだひとつあります = There is still one left!)



DON'T DO THIS!

Using **まだ** with a Simple Past verb treats a finished, dead action like it's still alive.

CORRECTION:

If it's over, use '**Mou**' (Already).
If it's continuing, stick to '**~te imasu!**'

Mada (まだ) Cheat Sheet



- **Structure:** まだ + Verb (Positive / ~te iru)
- **Meaning:** Still / More.
- **Use for:** Continued states or remaining amounts.
- **Vibe:** Things haven't ended yet!
