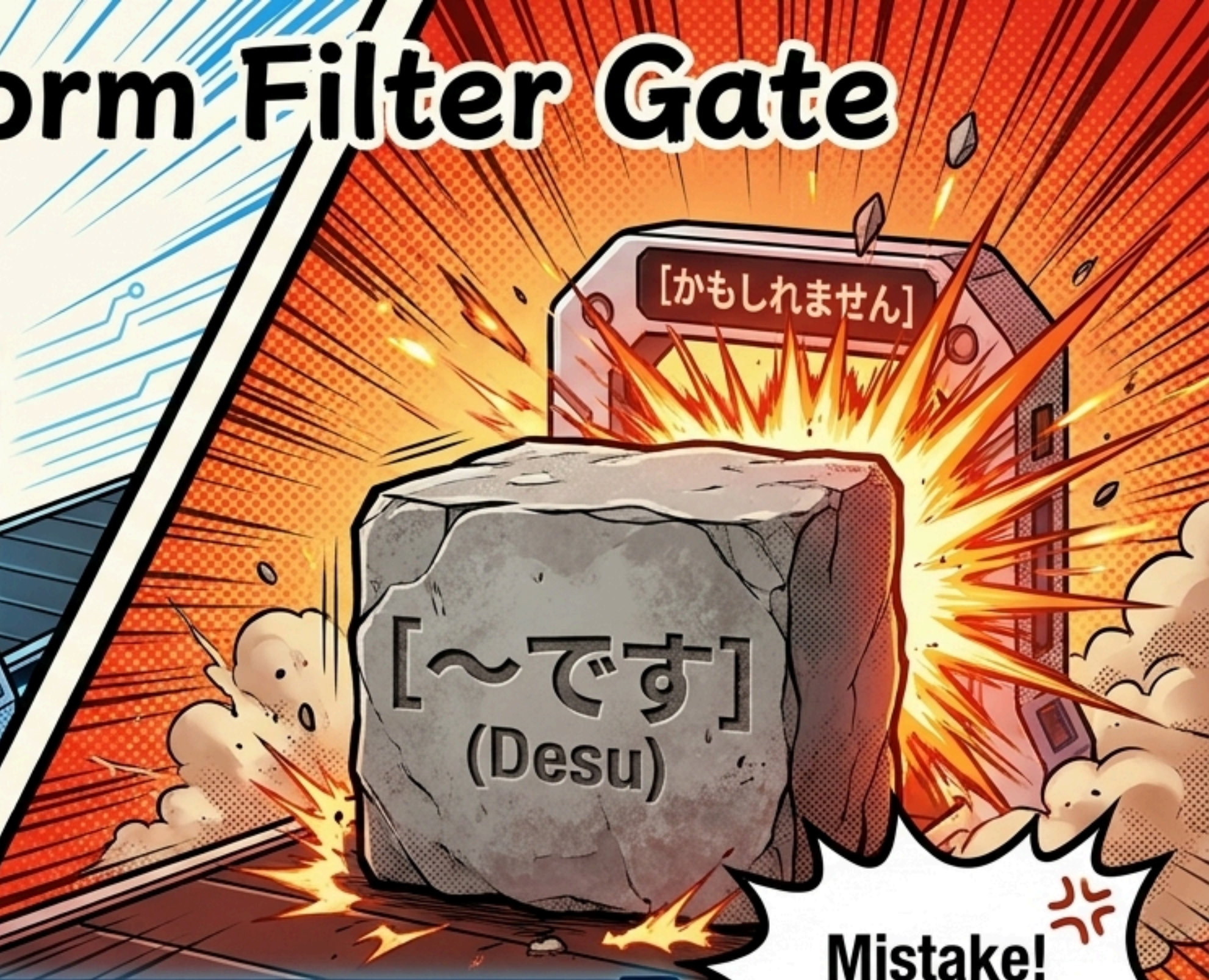


The Guesswork



Use 'Kamoshiremasen' when you aren't 100% sure.
It's perfect for giving your opinion: 'It might be cold' or 'It might be expensive'.

The Plain Form Filter Gate



Oishii (is)



Oishii kamoshiremasen.

Oishikatta (was)



Oishikatta kamoshiremasen.

Mistake!
Cannot pass!

Sentence Build Line



この ラーメンは からい かもしれません。
(This ramen might be spicy.)

Raya's Hack

Does it have a
heartbeat?

For present tense, I-adjectives
must keep their “い” (i) alive!

Oishi-i kamoshiremasen!
(Heartbeat detected 💖)

Don't do this! X

「おもしろいでした
かもしれません！」




**X Using
~Desu / ~Deshita**

Mentor Bar

Joy! You can't use 'Deshita' inside this sentence!
Use the Plain Past (Katta form) → Omoshirokatta kamoshiremasen.
(It might have been interesting.)



Summary Cheat Sheet



Present:	[Adj- い]	+ かもしれせん (Might be)
Negative:	[Adj- くない]	+ かもしれせん (Might not be)
Past:	[Adj- かった]	+ かもしれせん (Might have been)

Rule: Never use 'Desu' before Kamoshiremasen!
