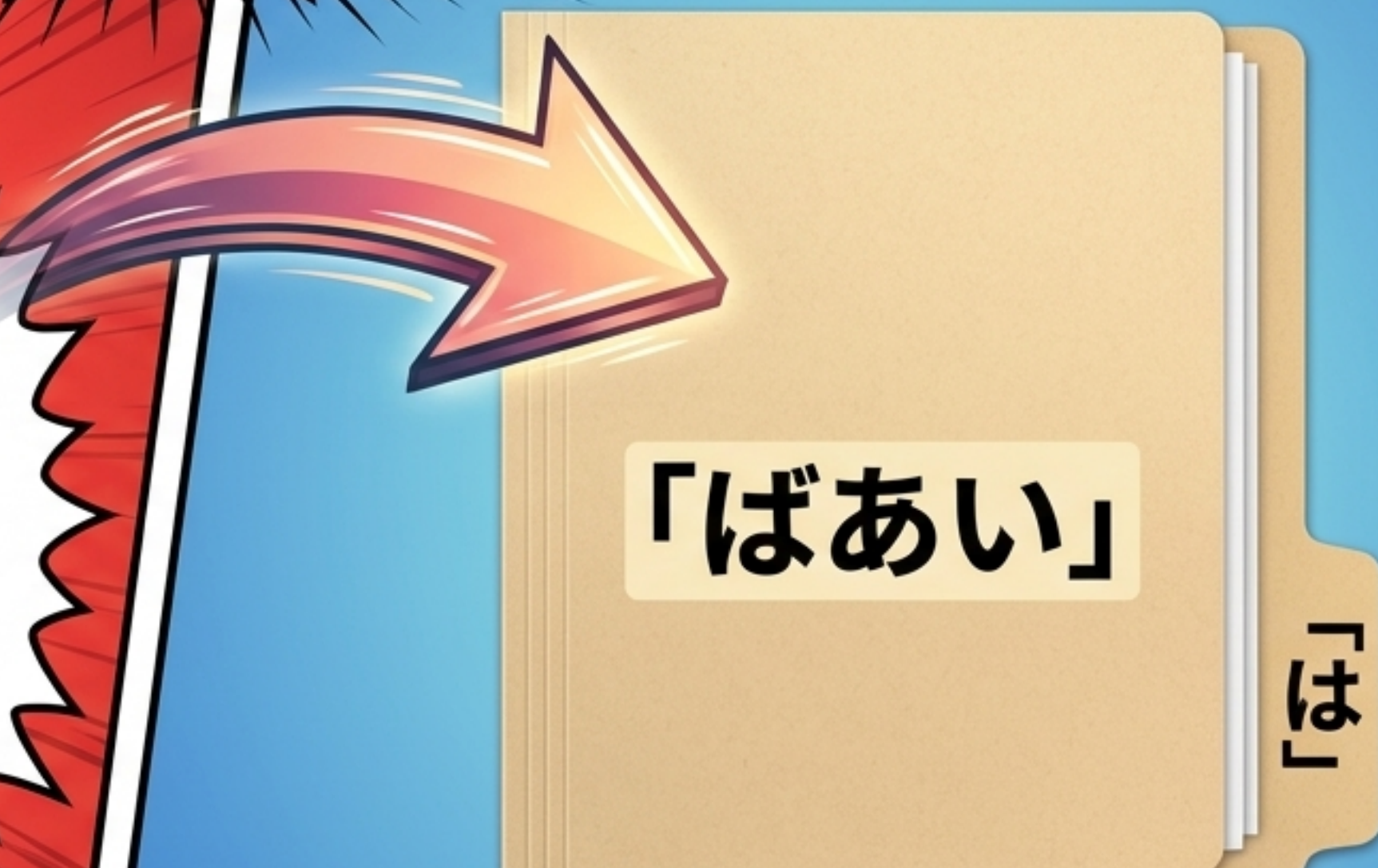
Handling Unfavorable or Specific States

The "Noun Modifying Pocket"



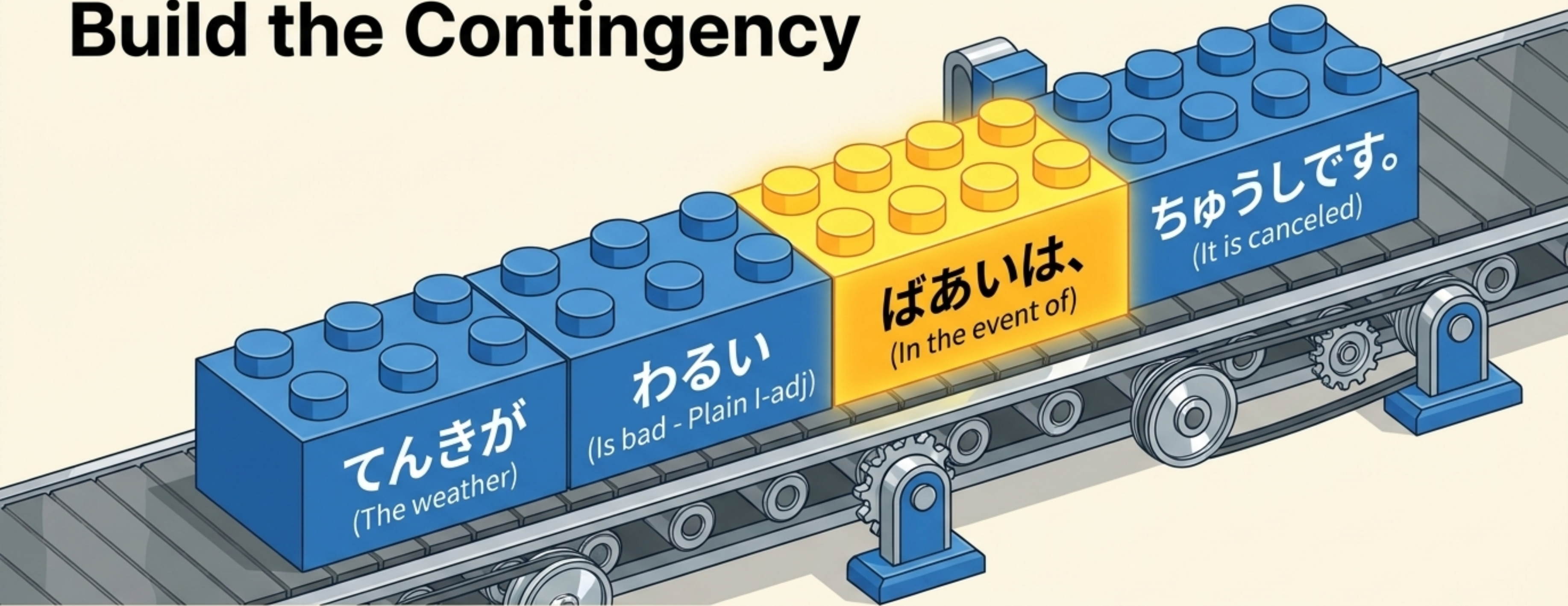
Because

Build the Contingency



てんきが わるい ばあいは、ちゅうしです。
(In the event that the weather is bad, it is canceled.)

Raya's Hack!

Present: わるい ばあいは (In case it's bad)

Negative: わるくない ばあいは (In case it's not bad)

Past: わるかった ばあいは (In case it was bad)

All short forms
fit into BAAI!

DON'T DO THIS!



わるいです
ばあいは...



「わるいです
ばあいは！」×

Strip away "desu" completely!



ぐあいがわるい ばあいは
(In the event you feel unwell).



Cheat Sheet

Structure: い-adjective (Plain Form) + ばあいは。

Meaning: In the case that.... / In the event it is...

Rule: Attach directly (わるい ばあい, あぶない ばあい). Never add です!

Examples:

- てんきがわるい ばあいは (In case of bad weather)
- ぐあいがわるい ばあいは (In case you feel unwell)
