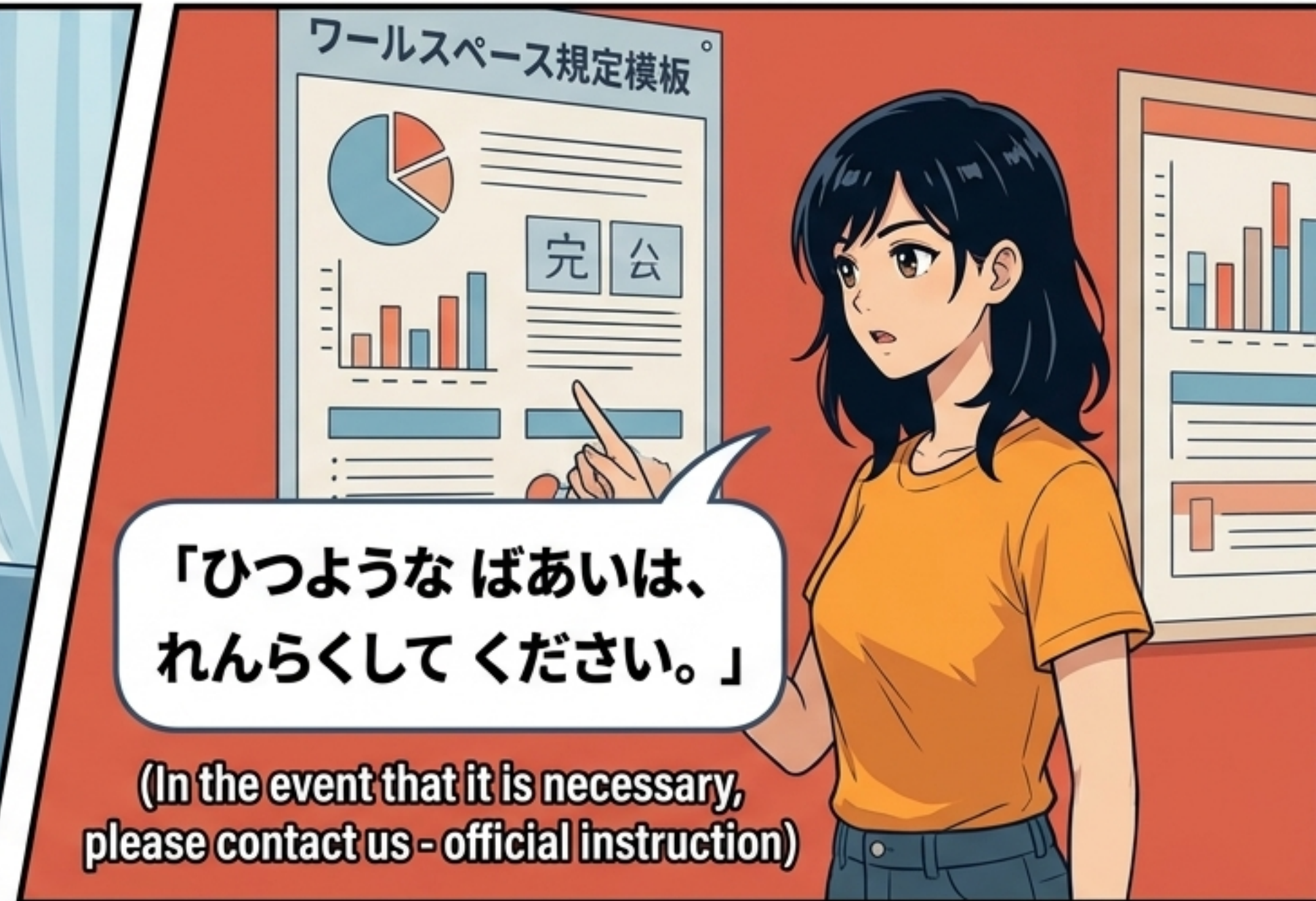


な-adjective + なばあいには (In the case that [Na-adjective])



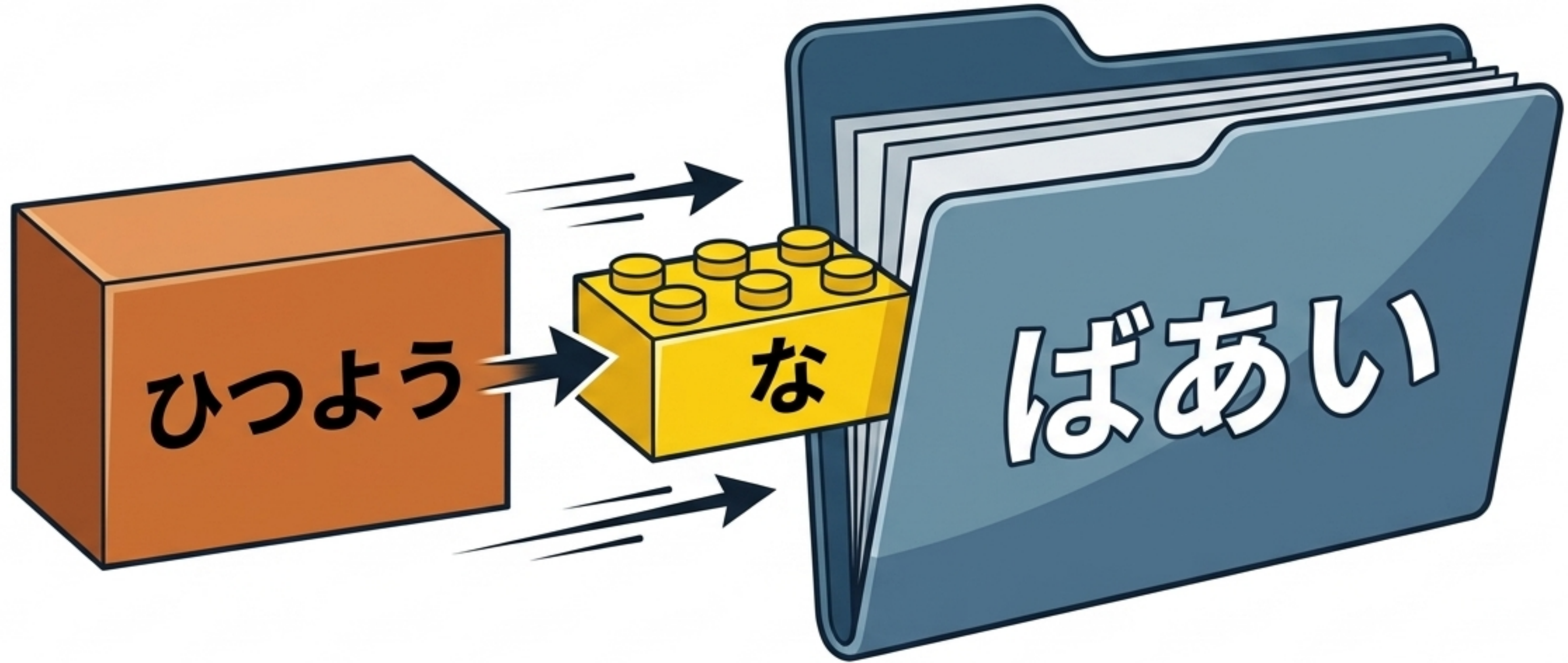
Concept:

Specifying Conditional States



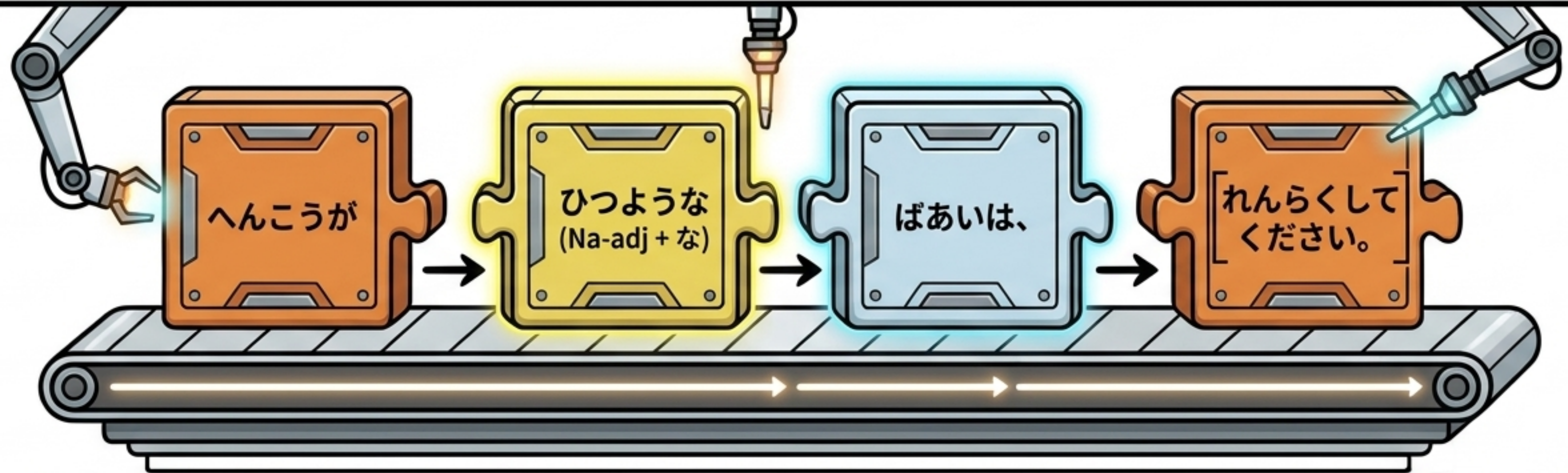
You can connect Na-adjectives to 'baai wa' to set up contingencies or official guidelines—like when help is necessary, or someone is free!

な-adjective Base + な + ばあいは



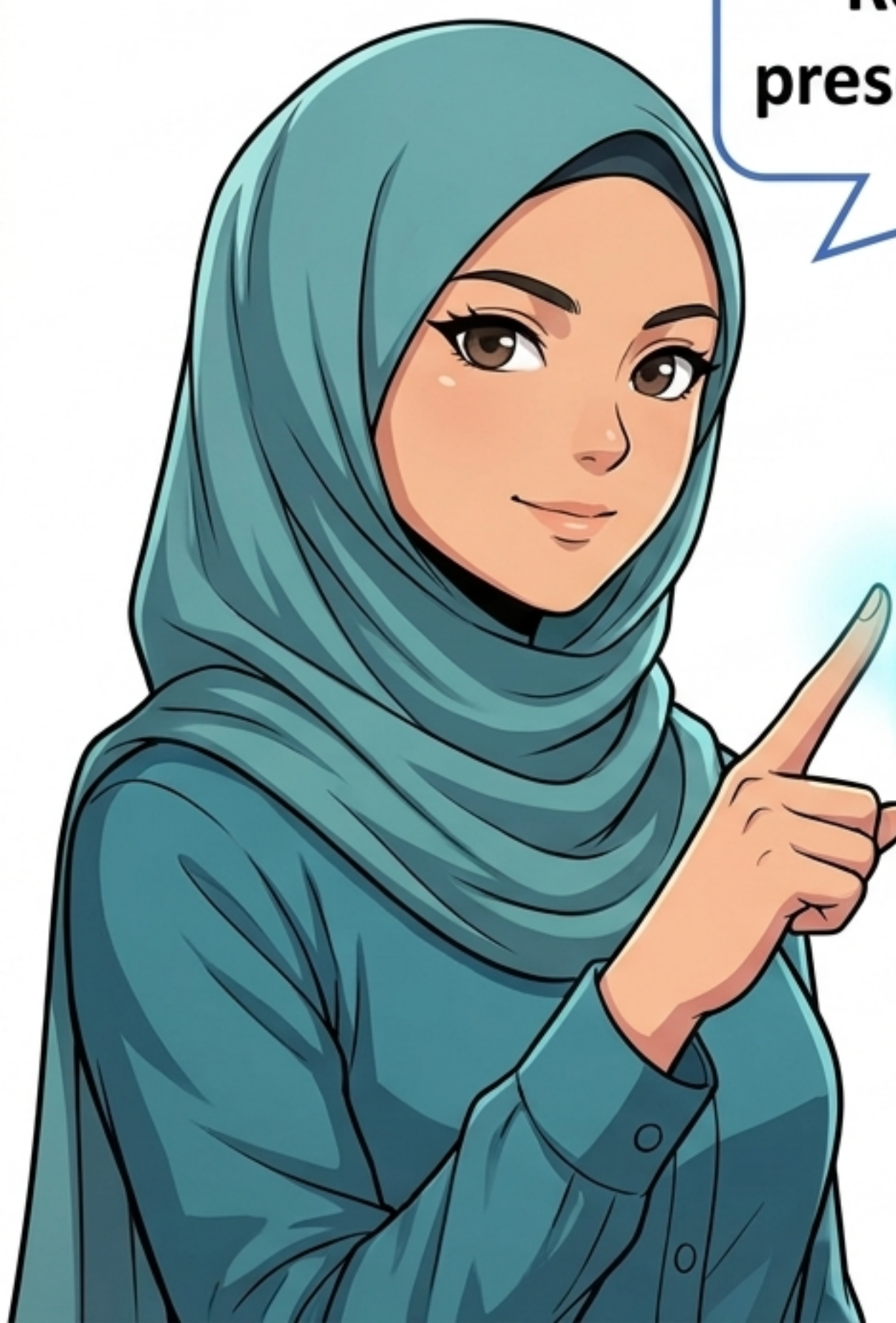
Baai is fundamentally a noun! Because it is a noun, Na-adjectives modify it just like any other noun—by attaching 'NA'!

Sentence Structure Assembly Line



へんこうが ひつような ばあいは、 れんらくしてください。

(In the event that changes are necessary, please contact us.)



Remember: NA for
present, DATTA for past!

Present Affirmative: ひつような ばあいは
(In case it's necessary)

Present Negative: ひつよう じゃない ばあいは
(In case it's not necessary)

Past Affirmative: ひつよう だった ばあいは
(In case it was necessary)

Don't do this!

「ひつようだ
ばあいは!」



**× Using "だ"
before ばあい**

Joy, don't use 'da' before 'baai wa'! Replace 'da' with 'na':
○ ひつような ばあいは (In the event that it is necessary).



Cheat Sheet

Structure:

な-adjective Base + **な** + ばあいは。

Meaning:

In the case that it is [adjective]... / In the event of...

Connection Rule:

Always use **な** in the present affirmative (ひつよう **な** ばあい, かんたん **な** ばあい). Never use **だ**!

Examples:

- ひつよう **な** ばあいは (In case it is necessary)
- ひま **な** ばあいは (In case you are free)
