please call 119.)

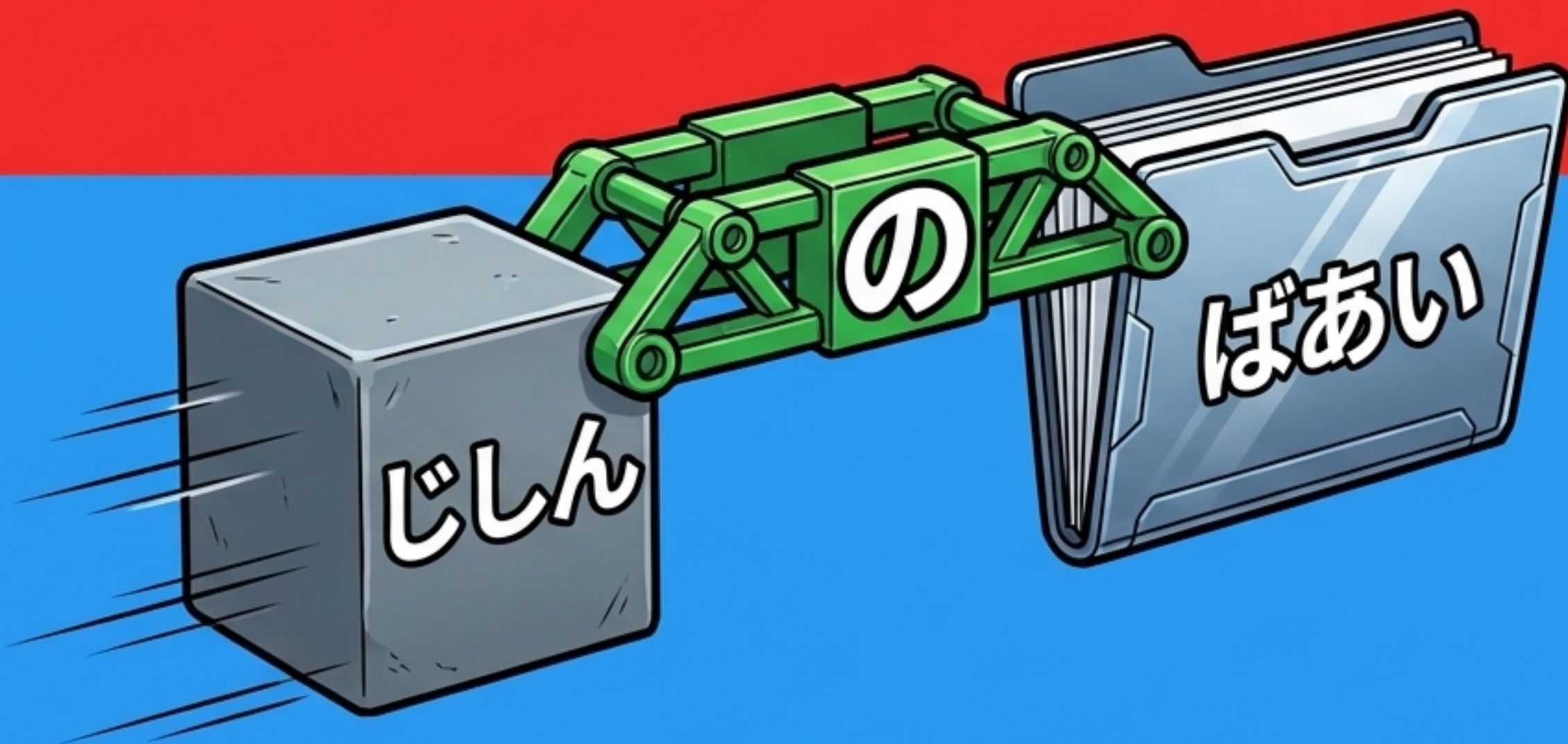


Used for setting up

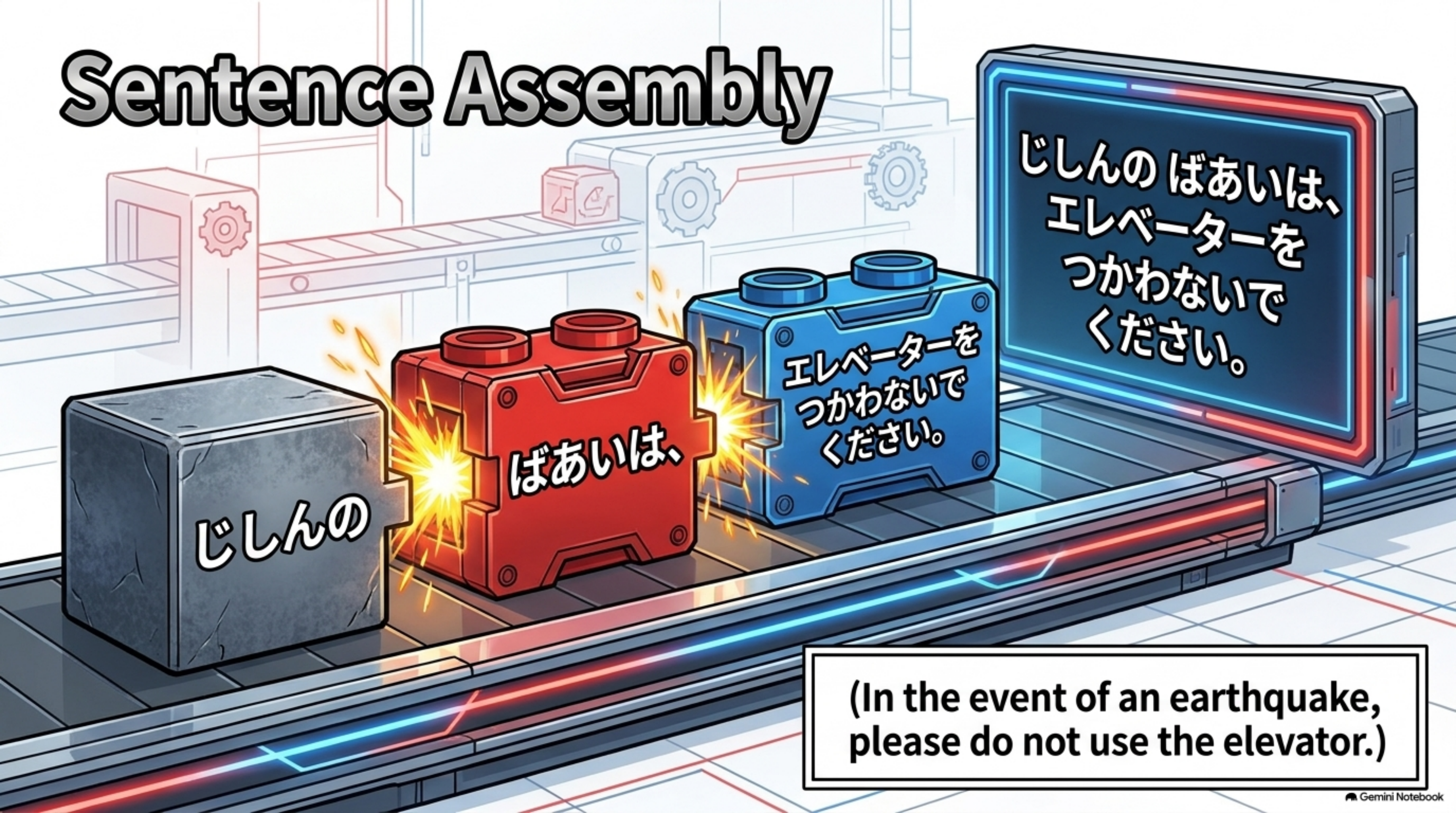
The 'NO' Bridge

Noun + の + ばあいは

'Baai' is fundamentally a noun! To connect two nouns together, you MUST use the trusty particle 'NO'.

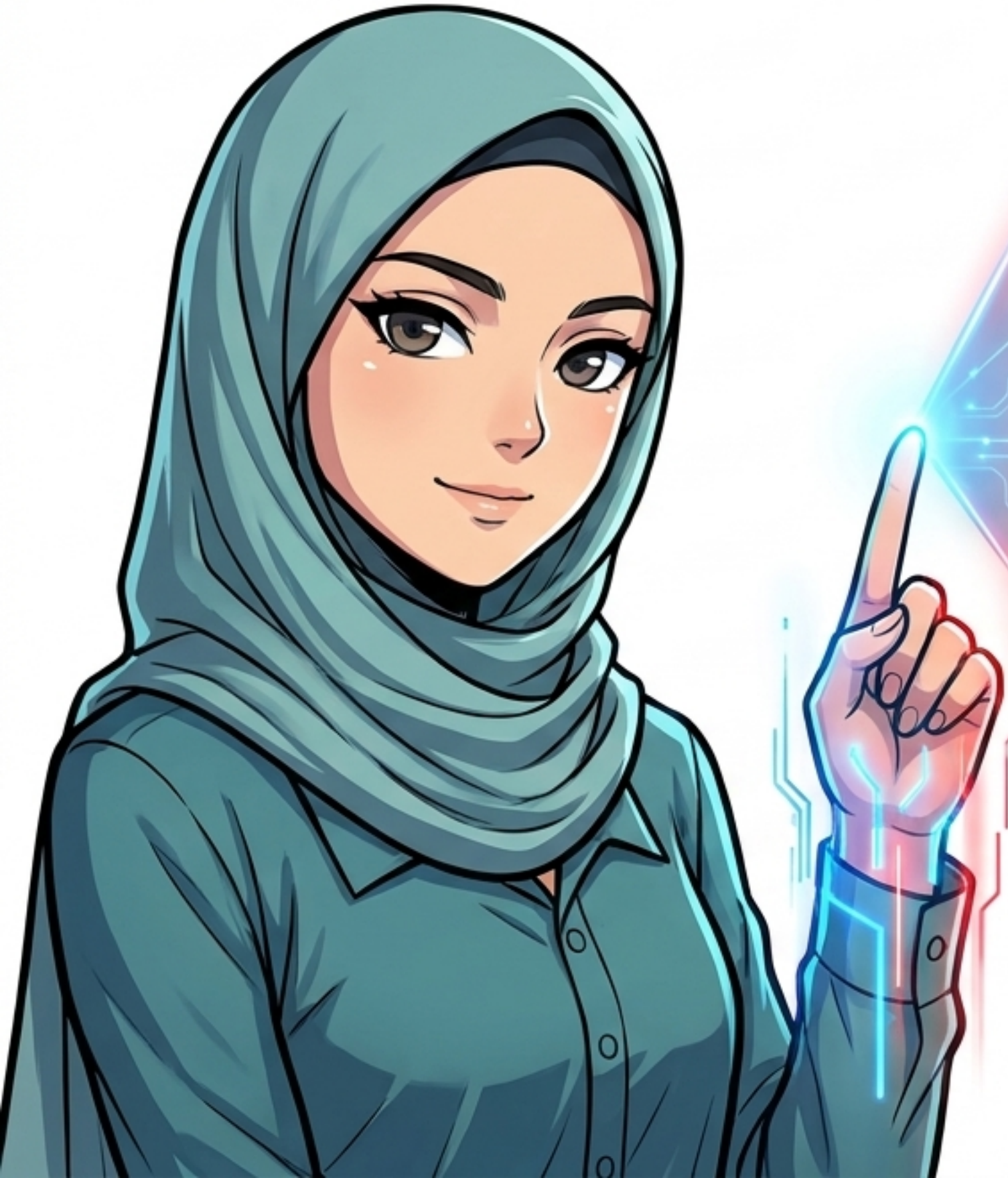


Sentence Assembly



(In the event of an earthquake,
please do not use the elevator.)

Raya's Hack: The Complete Baai Matrix!



Verb: ふる + ばあい

い-adj: わるい + ばあい

な-adj: ひつような + ばあい

Noun: かじの + ばあい

They all follow standard
noun modification rules!

Don't do this!

「かじだ
ばあいは!」

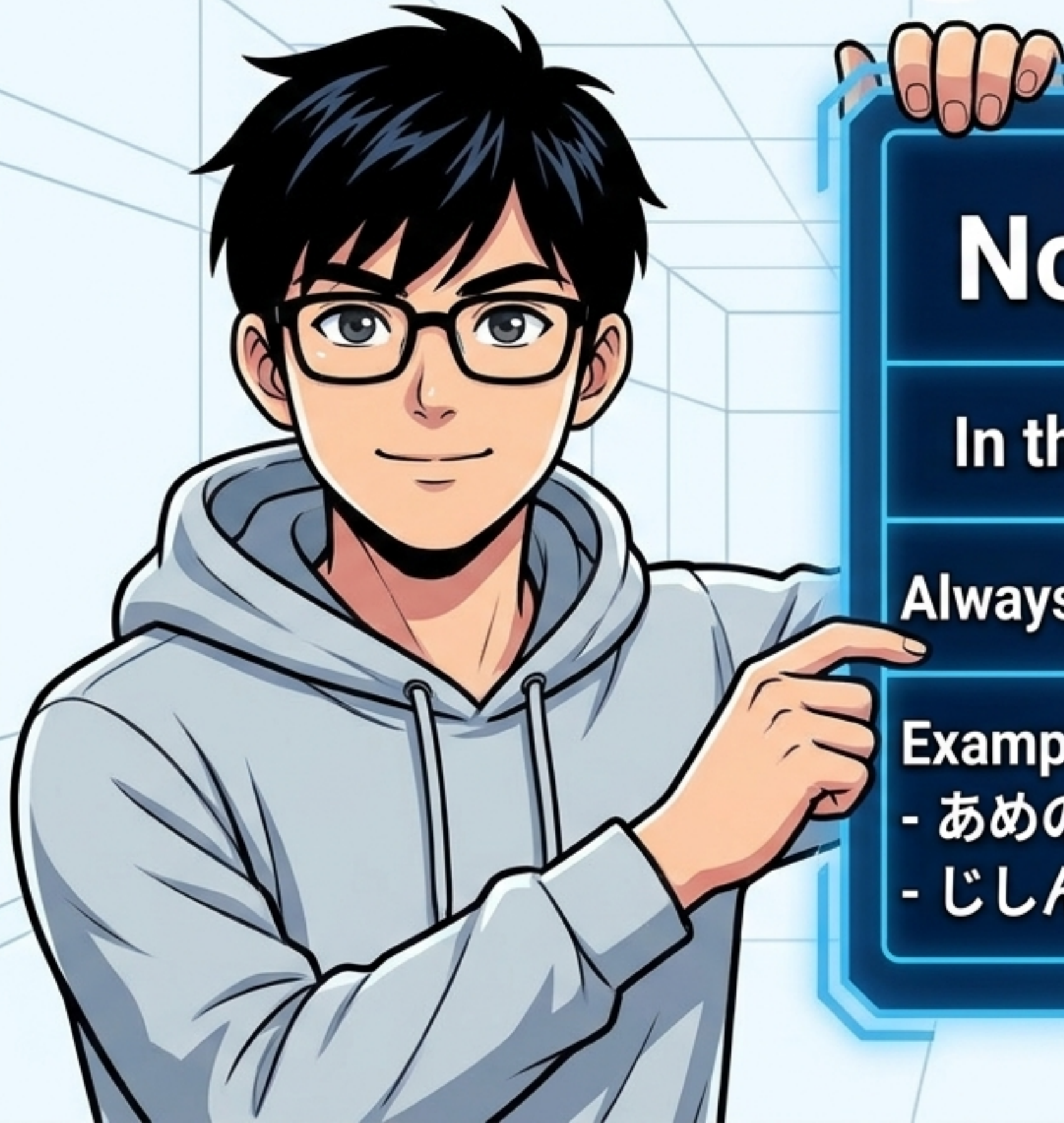
✗ Using "だ" before ばあい.

Never use 'だ'!

Replace it with 'の':

○ かじ の ばあいは

Summary Cheat Sheet



Noun + の + ばあいは。

In the case of / In the event of [Noun]

Always connect Nouns using の. Never use だ!

Examples:

- あめの ばあいは (In case of rain)
- じしんの ばあいは (In case of an earthquake)
