(Should be / Expected to be)

**Logical
Expectation!**

The Concept: Evidence Drives Expectation



No Evidence = No Expectation.



The Direct Quality Snap



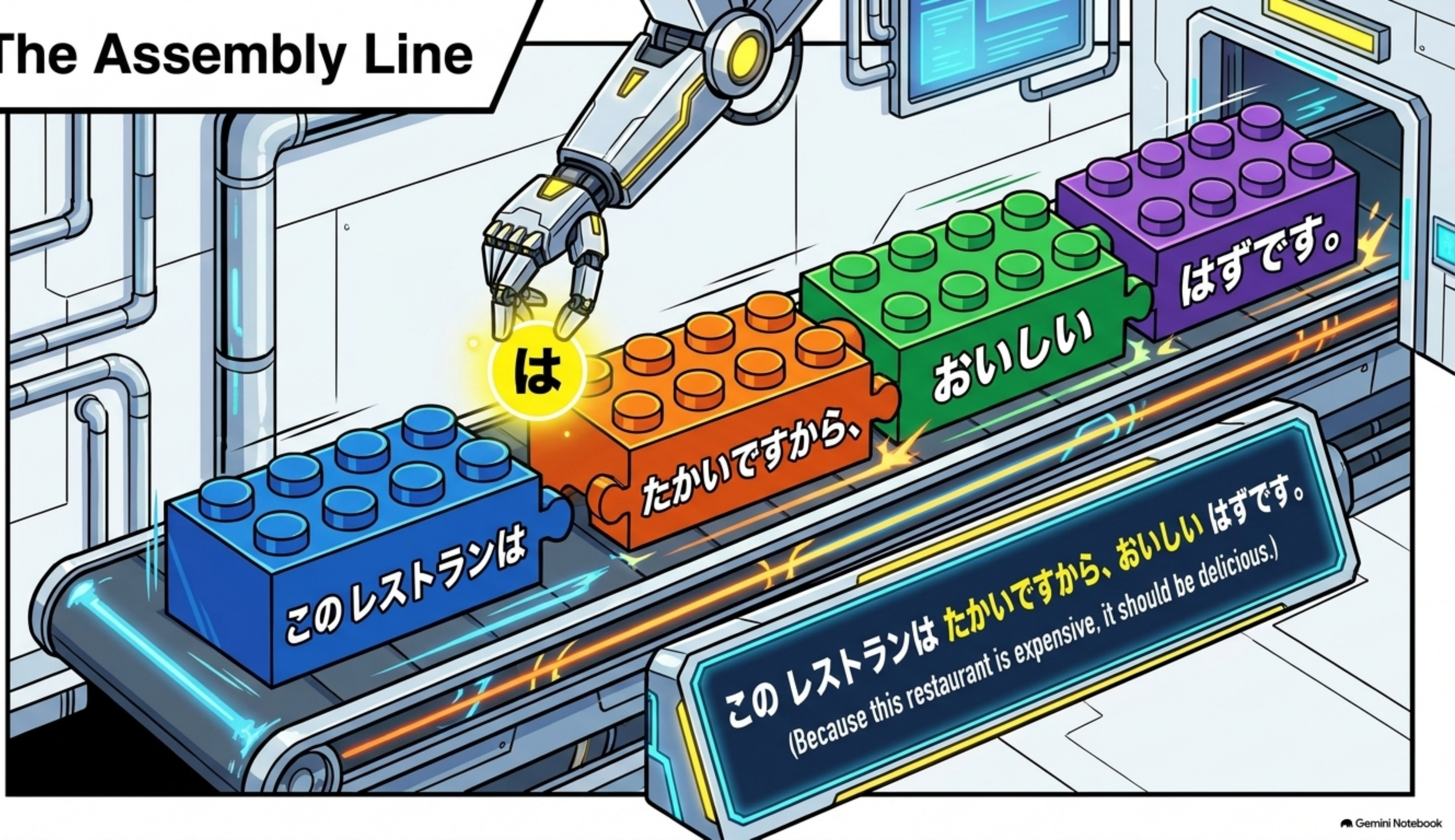
VERBS
(Living / Action)

い-adjective (Plain Form) + はずです
(No extra glue needed for states!)

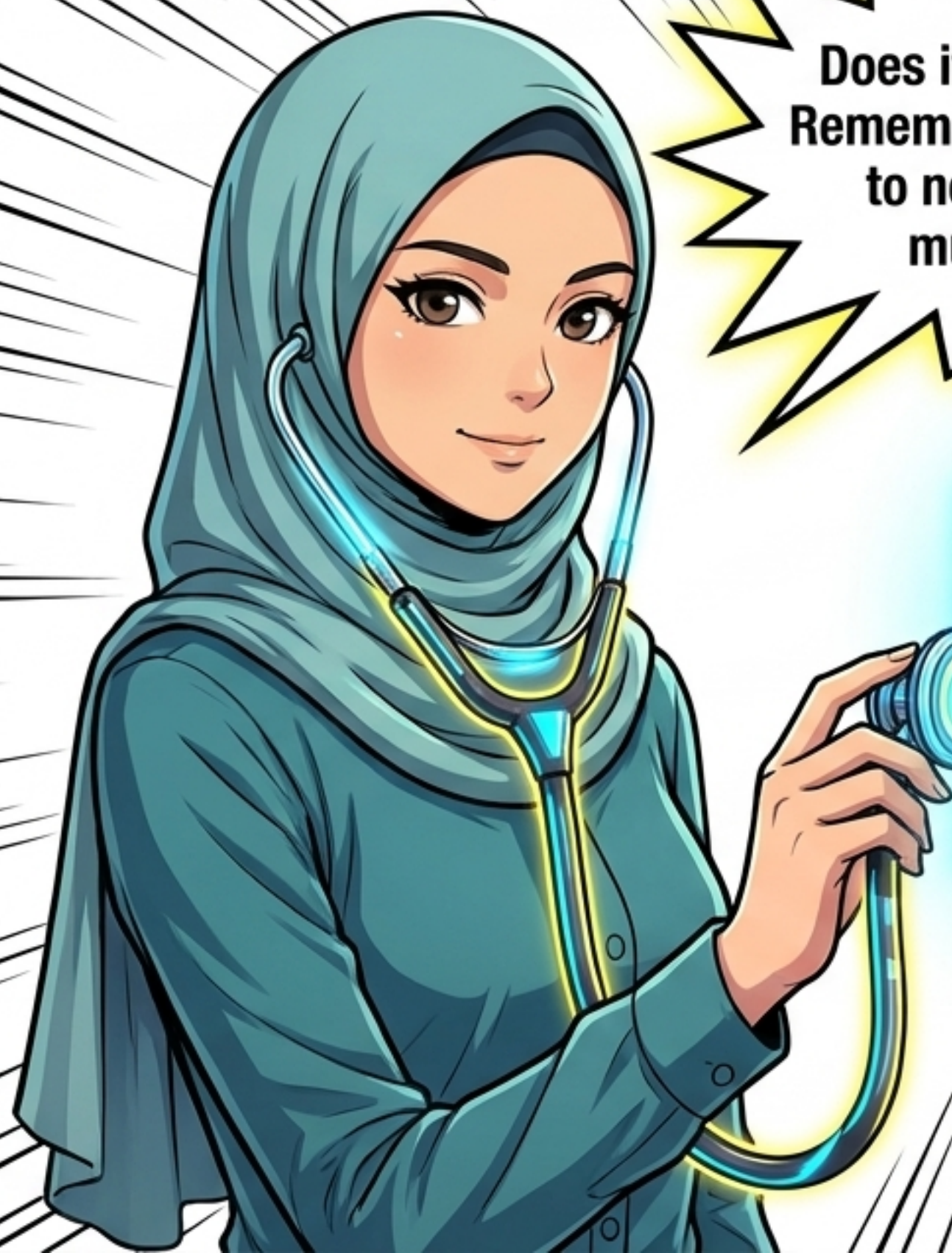


い-ADJECTIVES
(Stillness / State)

Raya's Hack: The "Heartbeat" Check



Does it have a heartbeat?
Remember, when いい shifts
to negative or past, it
mutates into YOI!



[Present Affirmative]: いいはずです
(Should be good)

[Present Negative]: よくないはずです
(Should not be good)

[Past Affirmative]: よかったはずです
(Should have been good)

DON'T DO THIS!

「やまのうへは
さむい
です
はず
です！」

× NEVER PUT **「です」**
BEFORE **「はず」**!

WRONG: さむい
です
はず
です

RIGHT: さむい
はず
です (It should be cold)

Keep the adjective in the Short/Plain form!

The Cheat Sheet



Structure

い-adjective (Plain Form) + **はずです**.

Meaning

Should be / Expected to be [I-adjective].

Forms

- Present: **おいしいはずです**

- Negative: **おいしくないはずです**

- Past: **おいしかったはずです**

The Golden Rule

Never put **です** before **はず**!

Keep the short plain form!

Examples

- **おいしいはずです** (Should be delicious)

- **さむいはずです** (Should be cold)
