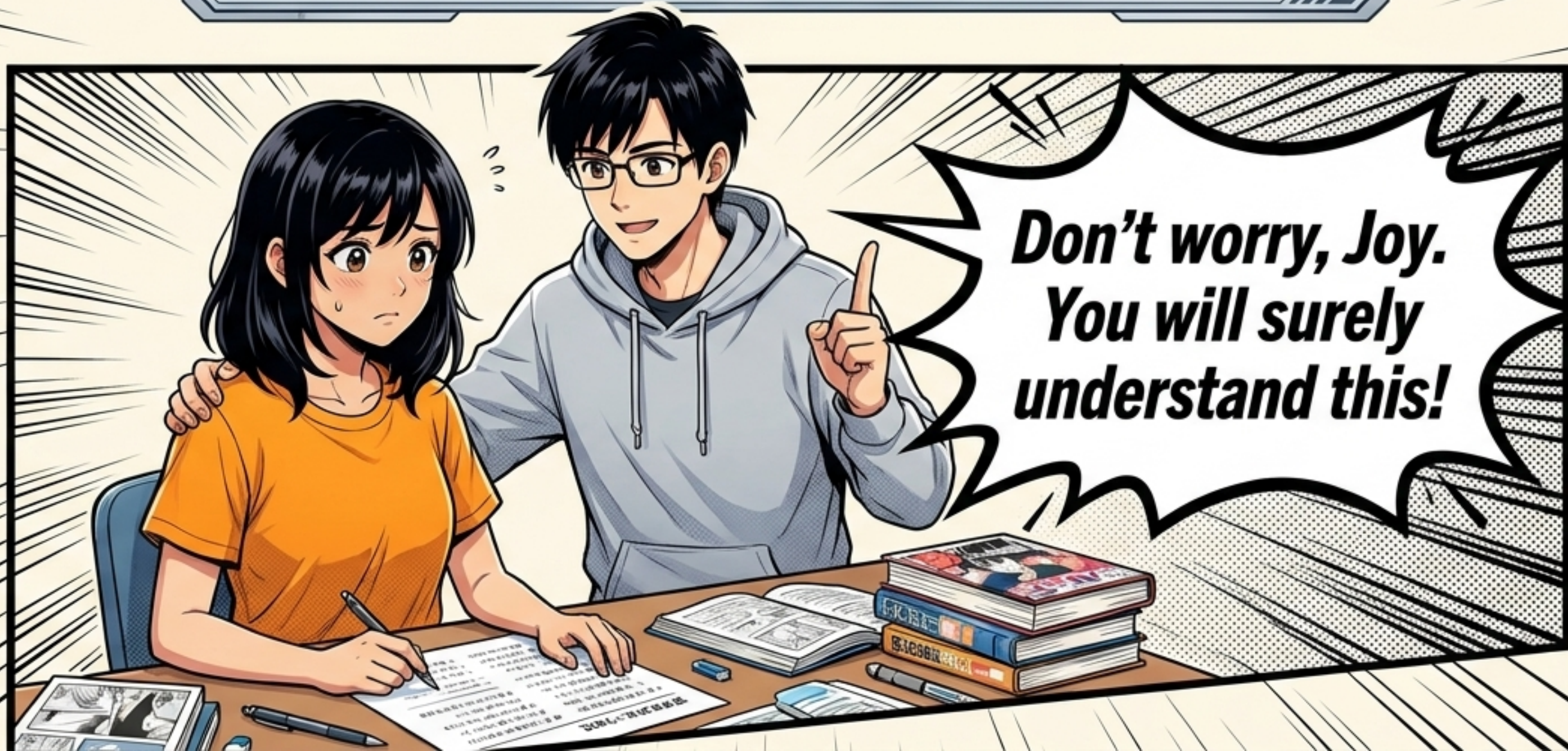
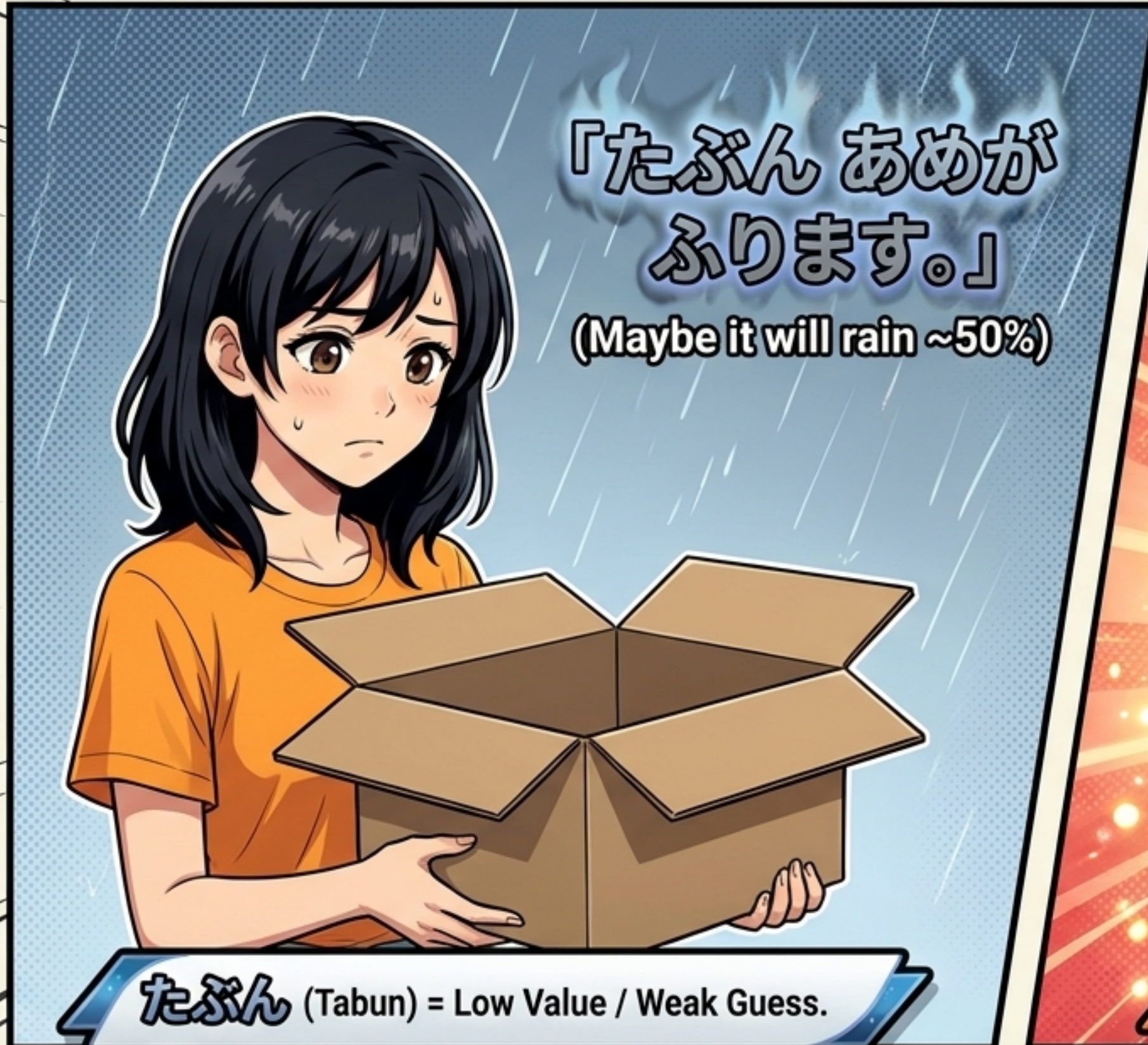

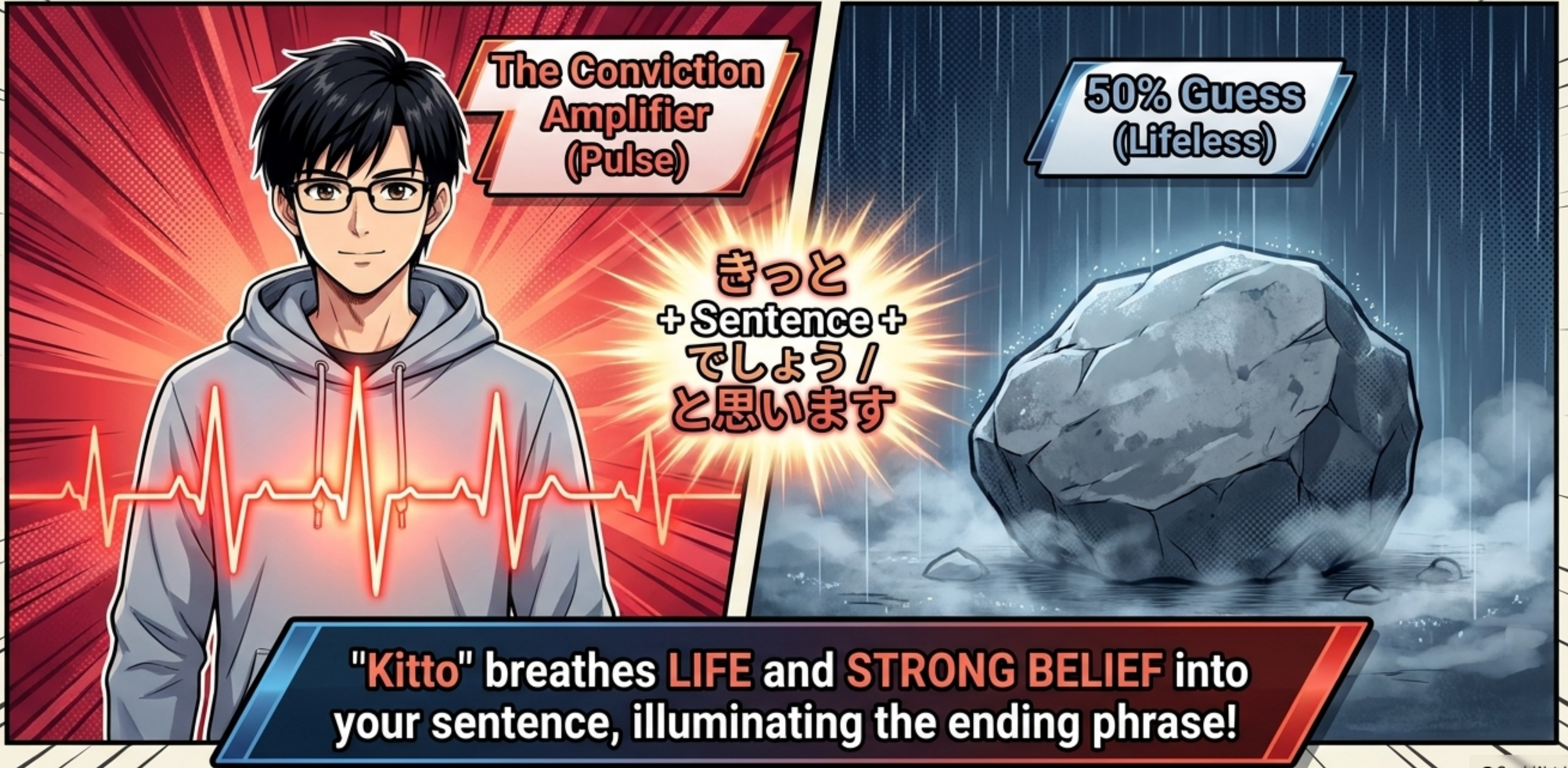

Diagnostic Matrix

たぶん (~50%):
Just a guess.
No emotion.

2



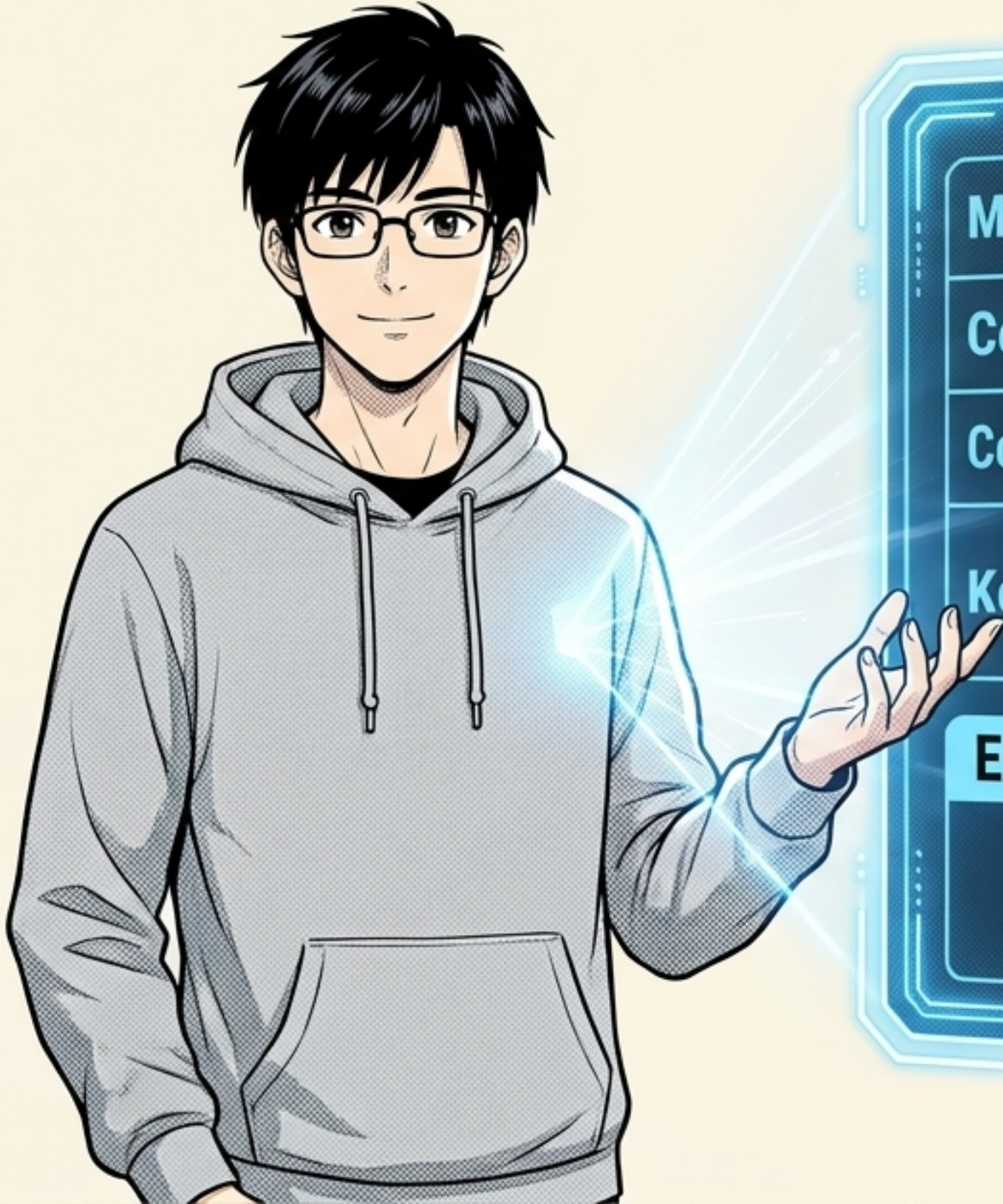
きっと (~90%+):
Almost certain.
**Strong belief &
reassurance!**

Use 'kitto' when you have a good reason to believe something, or when you want to cheer up a friend with a warm heartbeat: "Kitto daijoubu desu" (It will surely be okay!)

Don't Do This! (✗ The 50/50 Mistake)



Master Cheat Sheet for きっと



Meaning:	Surely / Definitely / Without a doubt.
Certainty Level:	High (~90%+ conviction or strong belief).
Common Endings:	~でしょう, ~と思います, ~はずです.
Key Purpose:	Reassuring others or stating strong expectations based on evidence or faith.

Examples:

- きっと きます (He will surely come).
- きっと だいじょうぶです (It will surely be okay).
