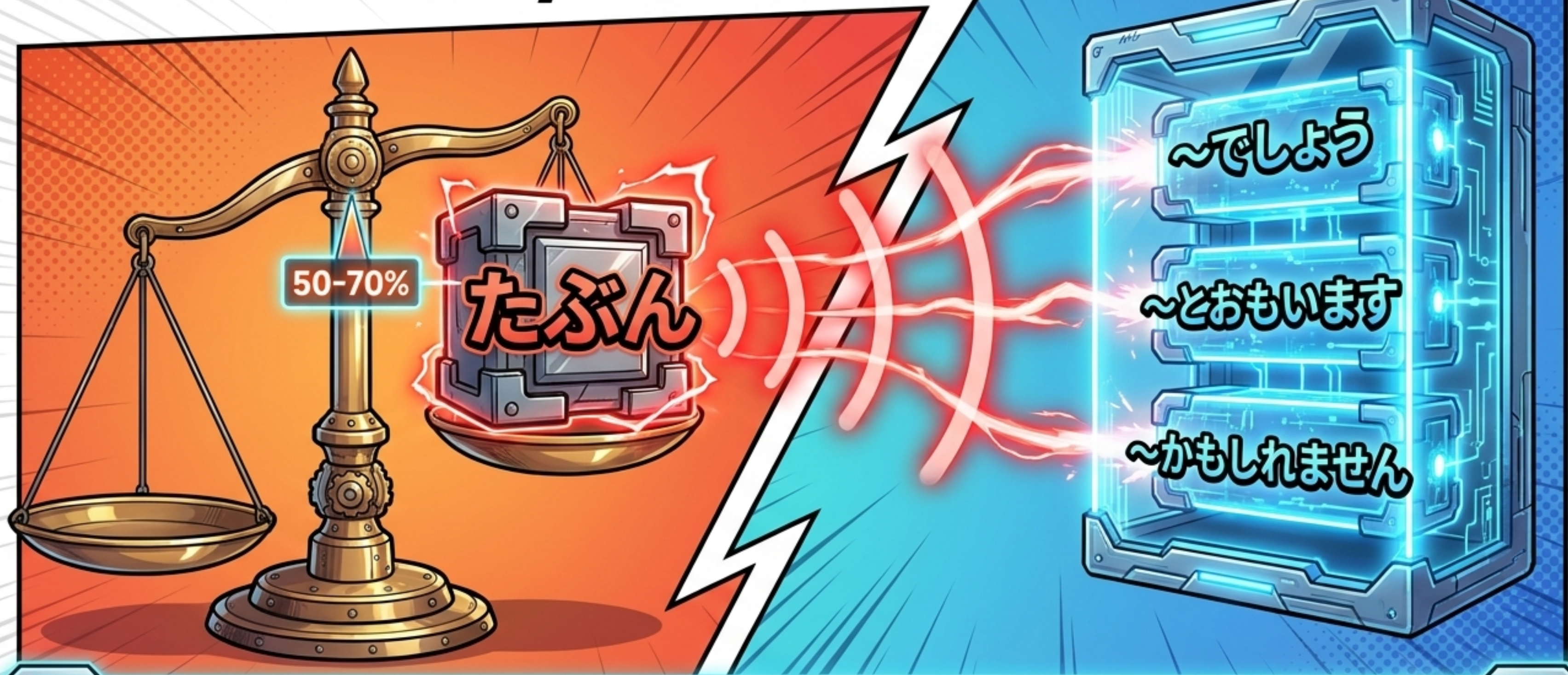

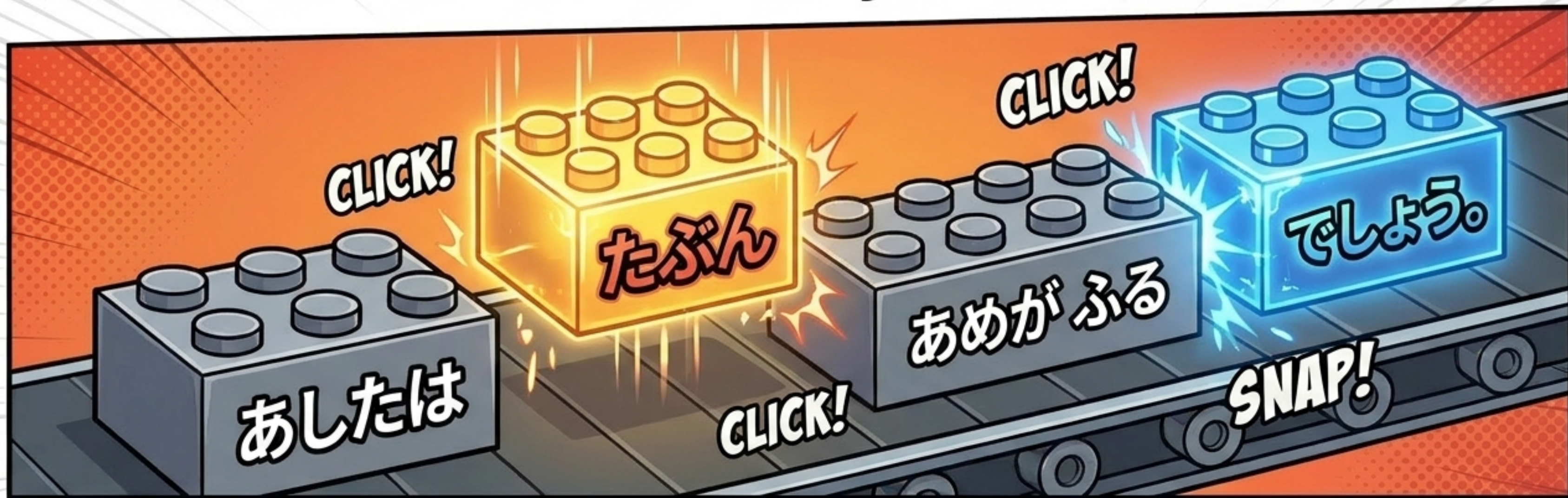


The Probability Scale

The Sentence Assembly Line



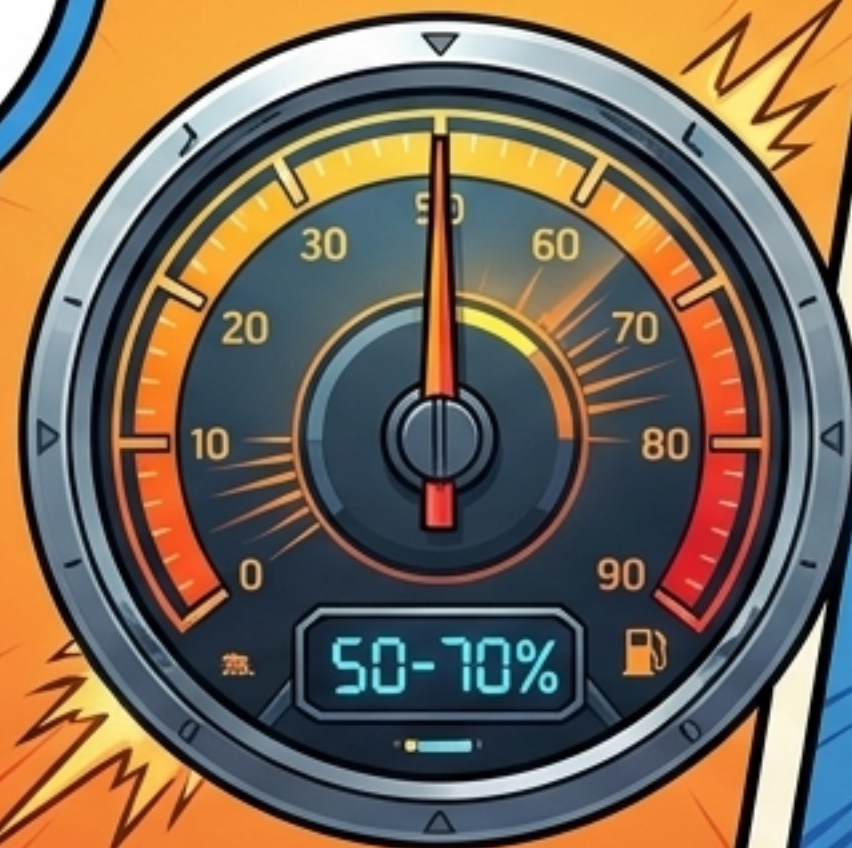
あしたは **たぶん** あめが ふる **でしょう。**
(It will probably rain tomorrow.)

Raya's Hack: The Certainty Gauge

Use 'Tabun' for realistic guesses, but use 'Kitto' when you want to show strong faith!

たぶん

Educated guess / Realistic



きっと

High faith / Encouragement



Don't Do This! **(✗ Reassuring Others)**



「たぶん
だいじょうぶです...」



**Joy, this makes it sound like you doubt me! To encourage someone,
always use: ○ きっとだいじょうぶです (You'll surely be fine!).**

Ken's Cheat Sheet



Meaning: Probably / Perhaps (~50-70% certainty).

Position: Placed before the verb or main clause.

Partners: ～でしょう, ～とおもいます, ～かもしれません。

Warning: Great for weather/schedules. Avoid using to reassure friends!

Example: たぶん きます (He will probably come).
