

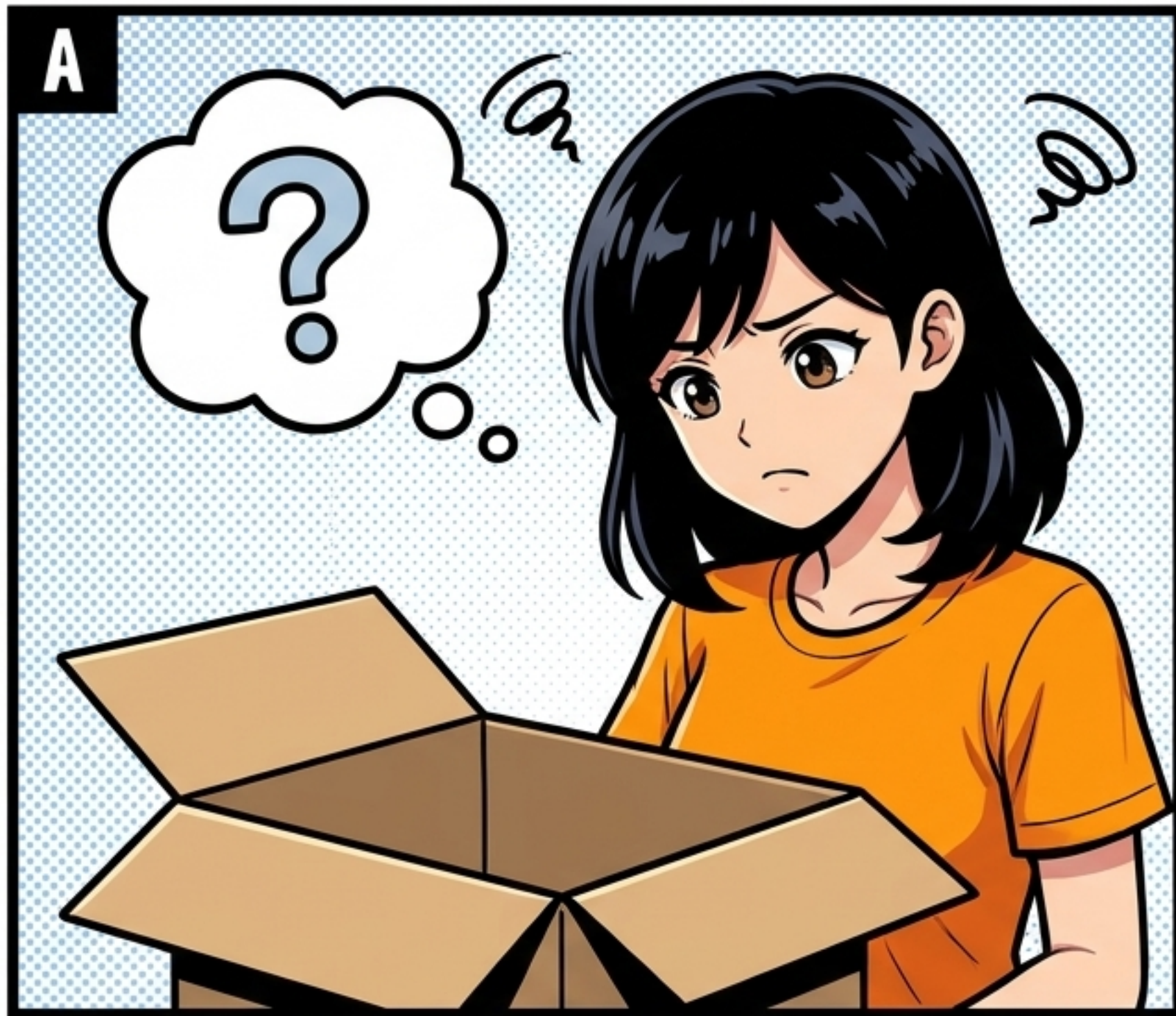

(It seems that / It appears that...)

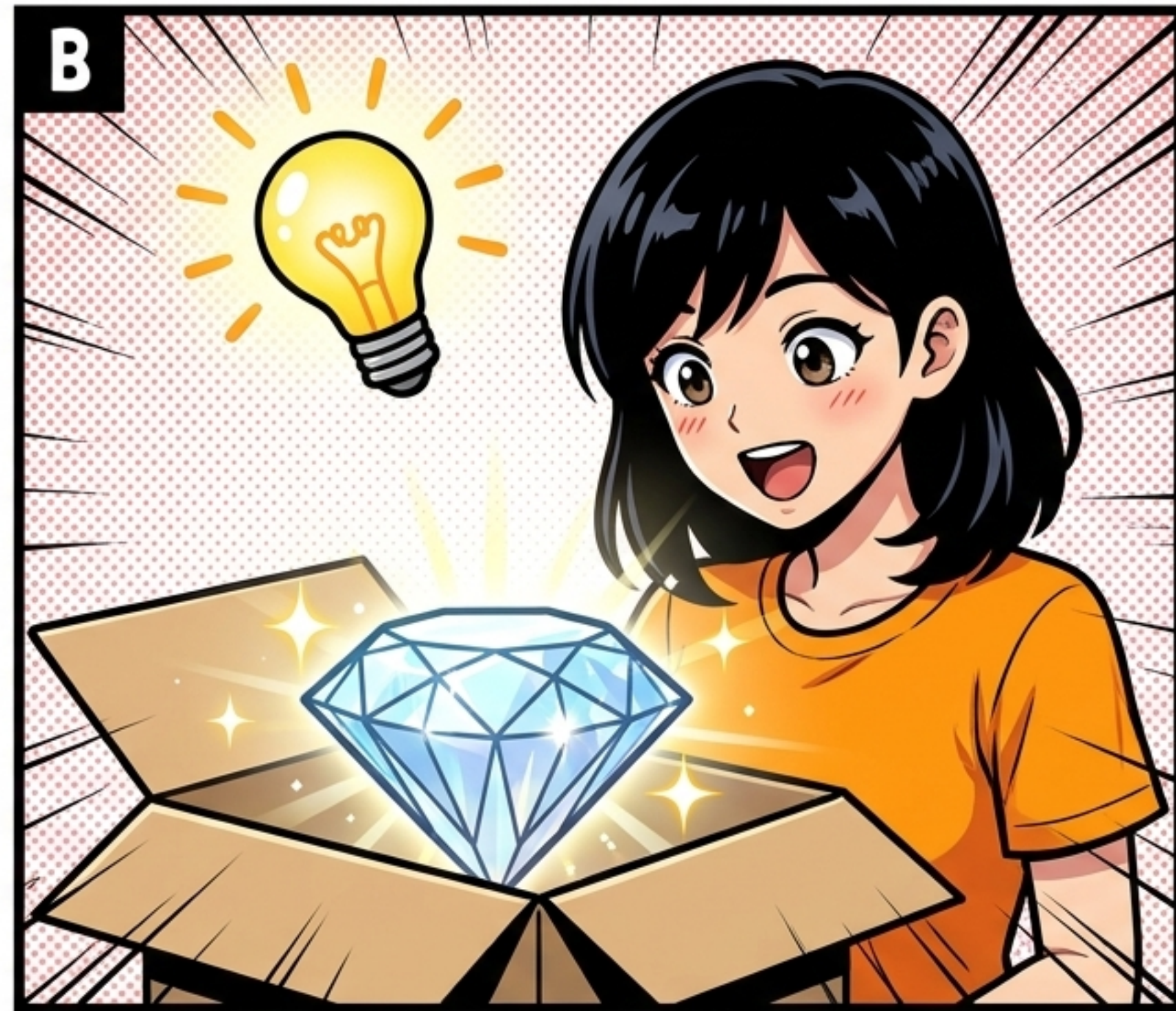


Concept: Observation-Based Deduction (状況からの推測)

# Looking for Evidence (証拠を探す)



**No evidence = No deduction.**



**Evidence found ⇒ たかいようです  
(It seems expensive).**

# Living vs. Non-Living Rule (生き物 vs 無生物)

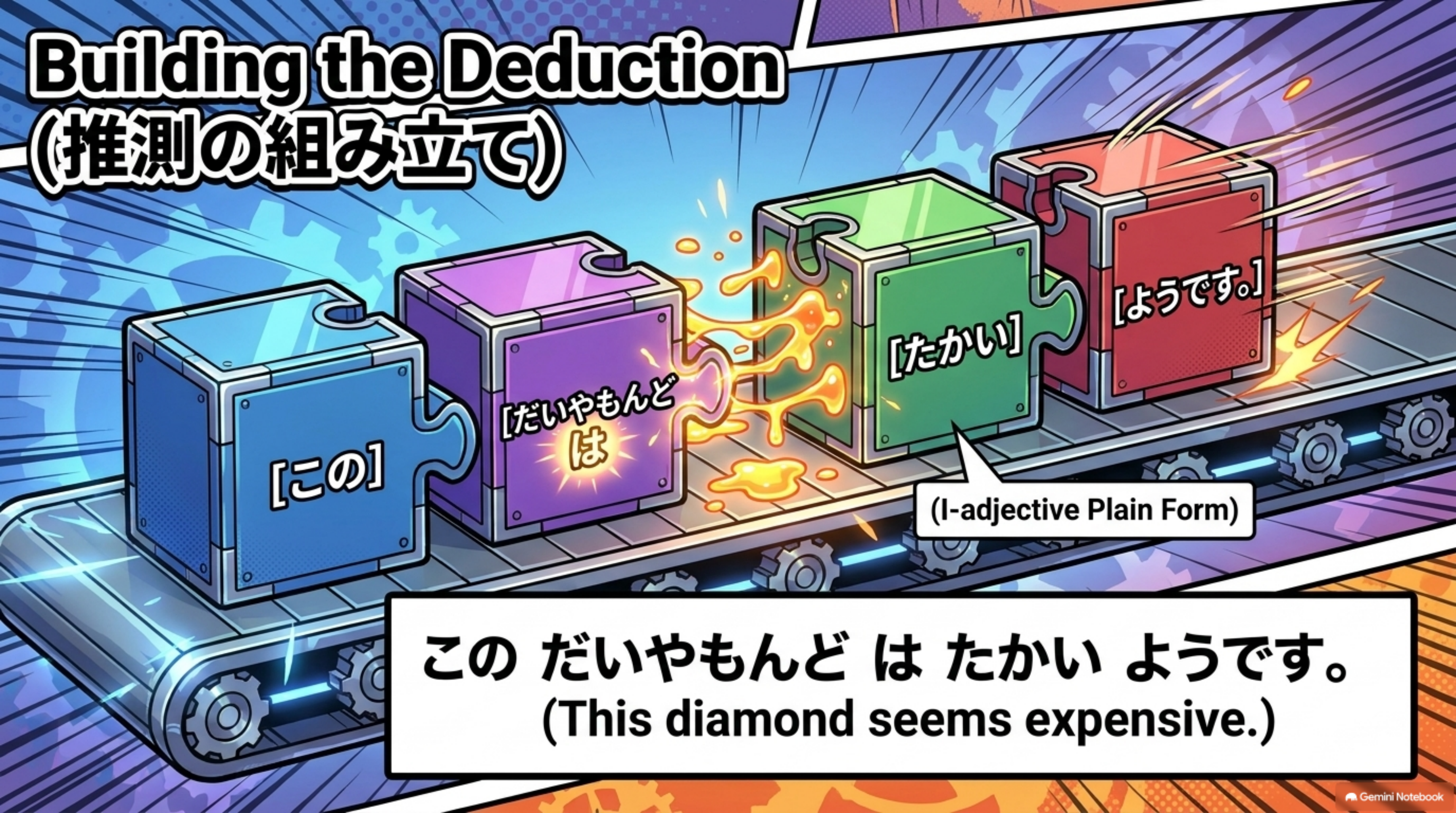
BLUE ZONE - NON-LIVING/STILL

つめたいです  
(It is cold - Fact).

RED ZONE - LIVING/PULSE

さむい  
ようです  
(He seems cold  
- Deduction).

# Building the Deduction (推測の組み立て)



[この]

[だいやもんど  
は]

[たかい]

[ようです。]

(I-adjective Plain Form)

この だいやもんど は たかい ようです。  
(This diamond seems expensive.)

**× ケンさんは さむい です。(Ken is cold.)**

# Cheat Sheet (まとめ)



Structure: [い-adjective (Plain)] + ようです

Meaning: It seems that / It appears that...

Rule 1: Keep the “い” (たかい ようです).

Rule 2: Requires objective visual evidence (a “pulse” / clues).

Rule 3: Use this to describe 3rd-party feelings instead of facts!
