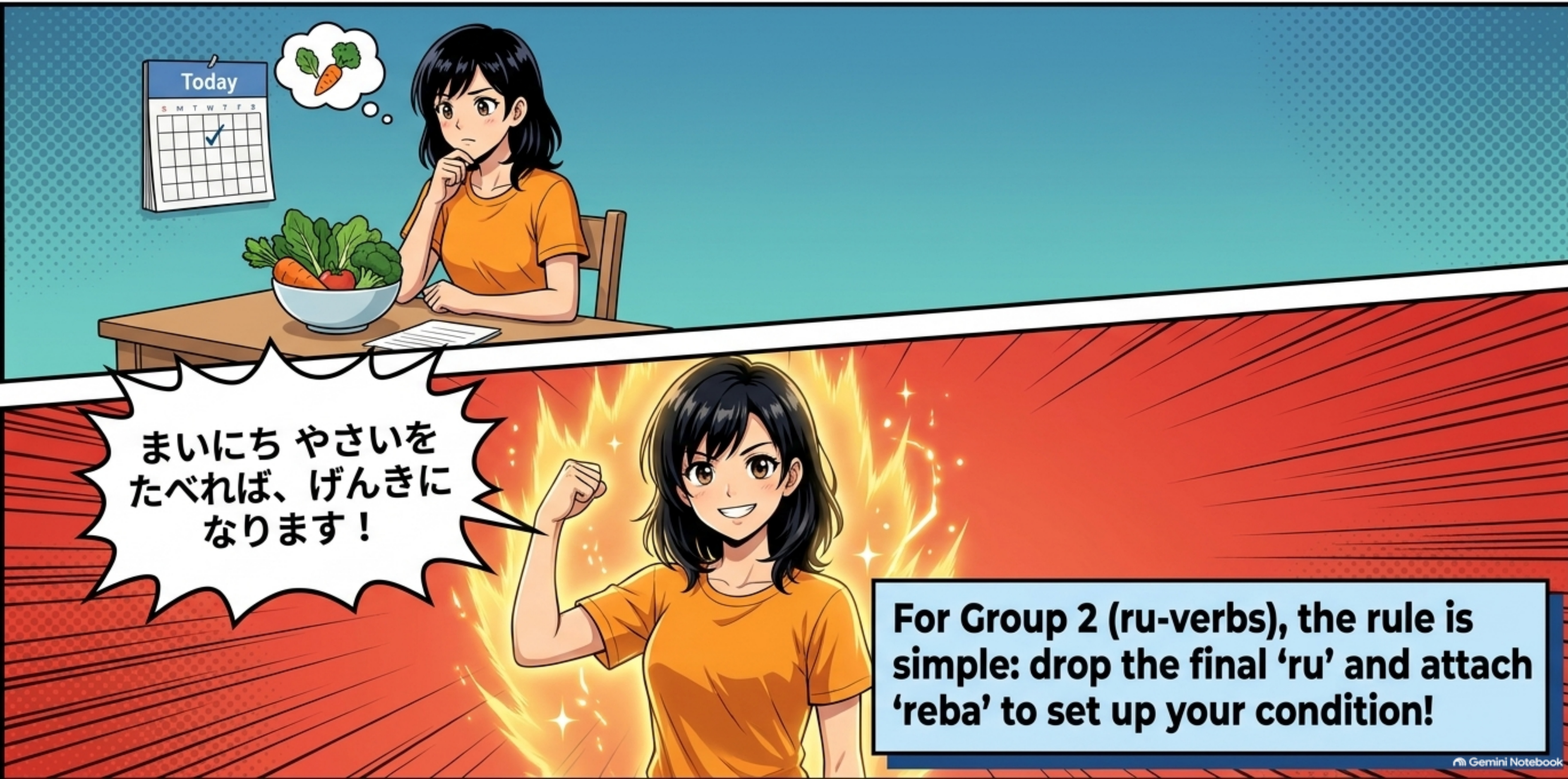


Group 2 Verb (ば conditional) + れば (If [Verb])

Hypothetical Condition & Result (条件・仮定)

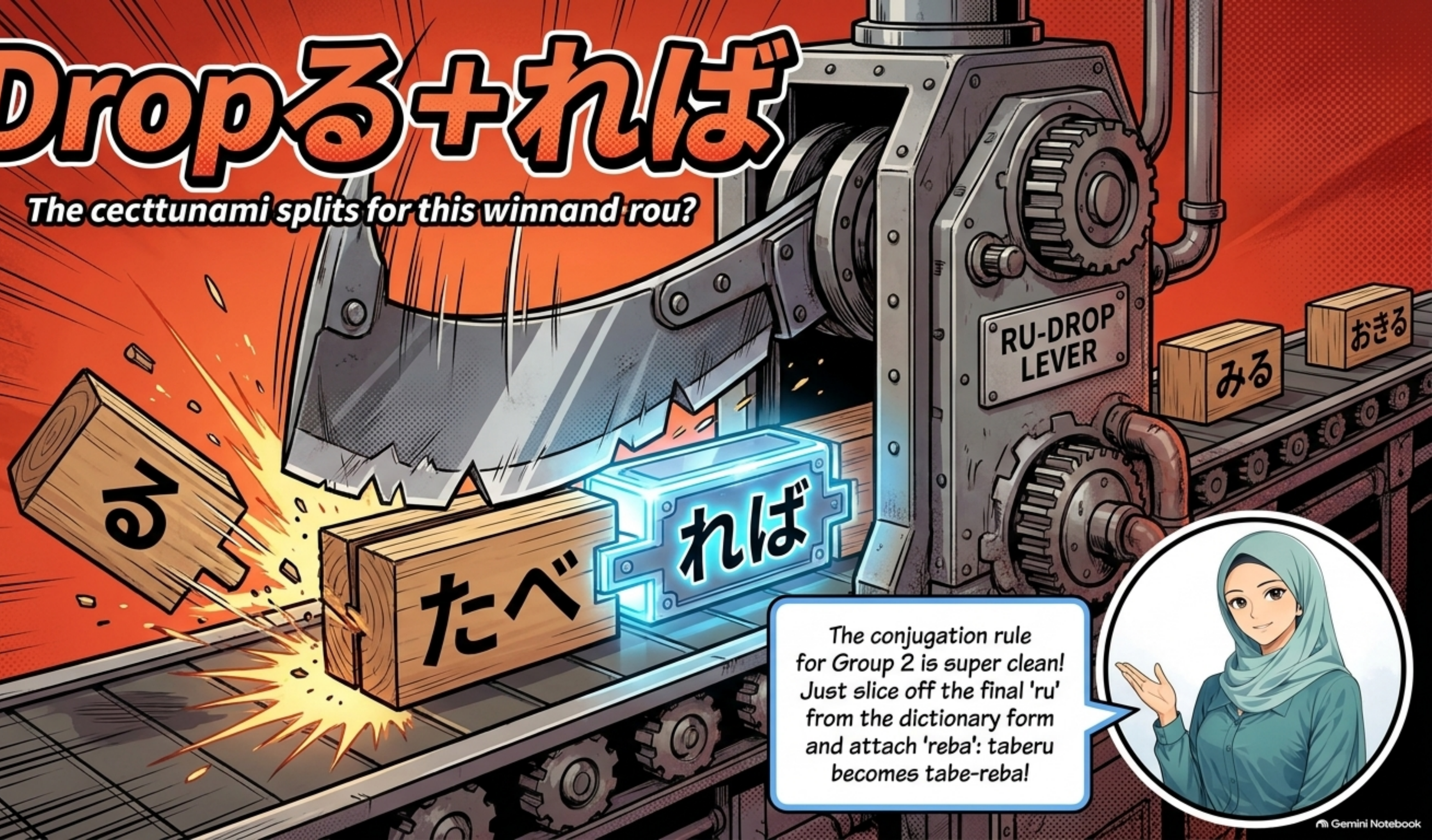


Condition ⇒ Guaranteed Result

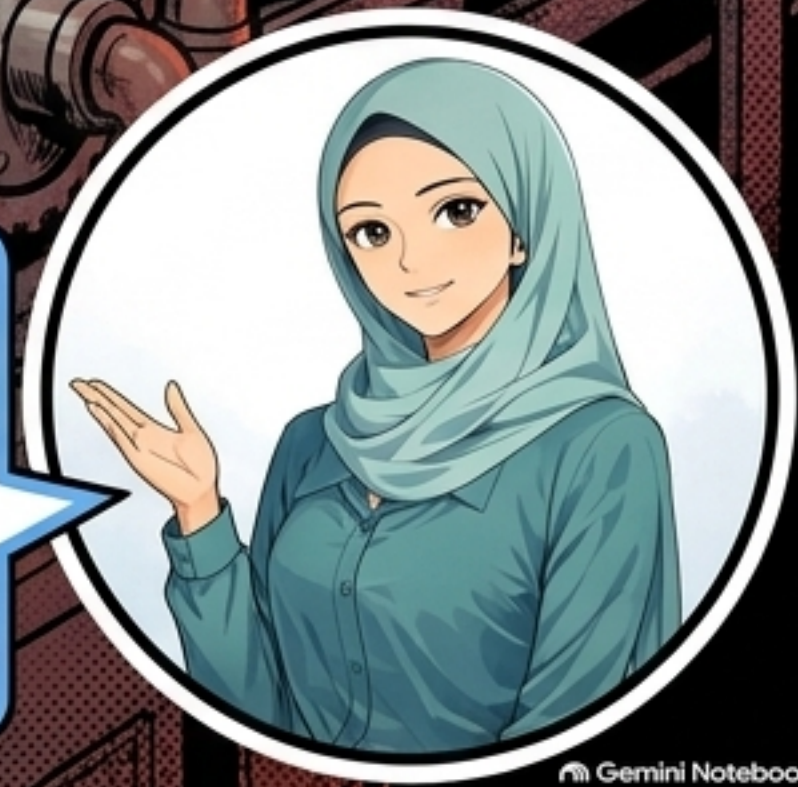

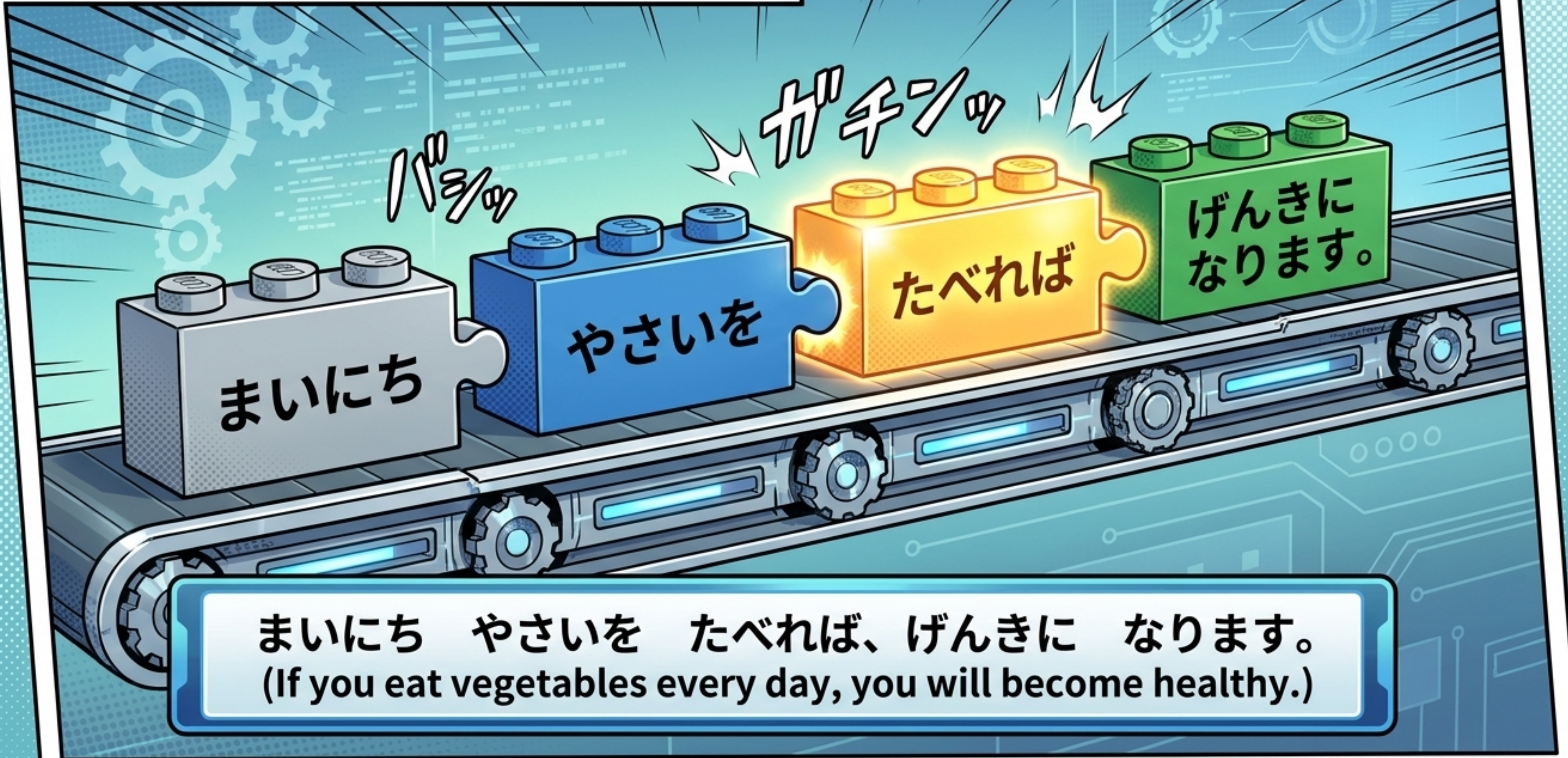

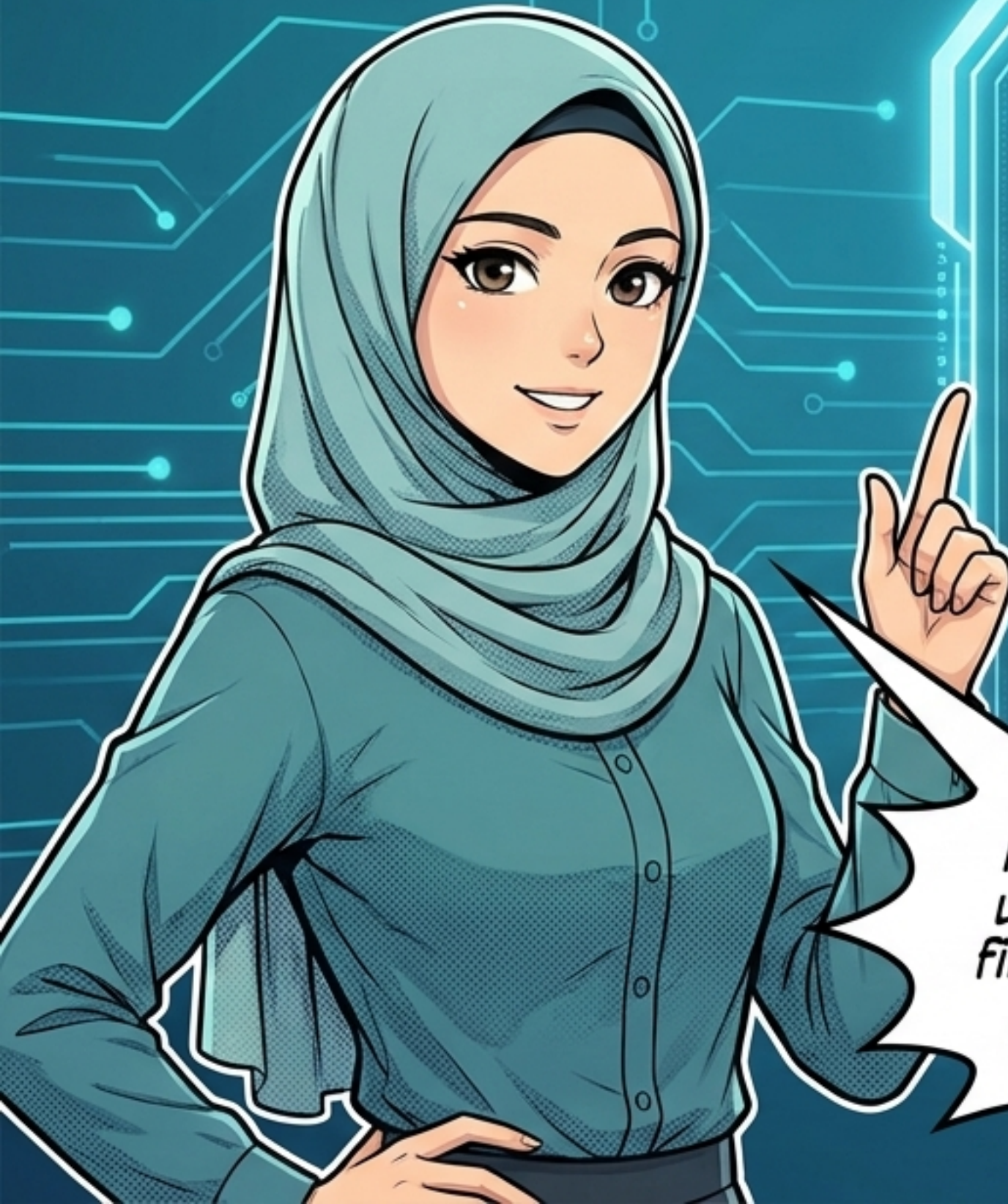
The conjugation rule for Group 2 is super clean! Just slice off the final 'ru' from the dictionary form and attach 'reba': taberu becomes tabe-reba!



Sentence Assembly Line



Raya's Hack: Group 1 (-eba) vs Group 2 (-reba)



Group 1 (u-verb): Change -u to -e + ば
(のむ → のめば, いく → いけば)

Group 2 (ru-verb): Drop る + れば
(たべる → たべれば, みる → みれば)

Here is the master hack! Don't mix them up! Group 1 shifts the final vowel to -e. Group 2 simply drops 'ru' - and adds 'reba'!

Don't do this!

✗ Attaching ば directly to the Dictionary Form (たべるば ✗)

たべるば、
おいしいです!

Joy, wait! You can't say taberu-ba.
For Group 2 verbs, you **MUST**
drop "ru" and add "reba":

○ たべる → たべれば

Group 2 (-ば) Cheat Sheet



Formula: Group 2 Verb Dict Form → Drop る + れば

Meaning: If [Verb] / Provided that [Verb]

Golden Rule: Always drop る before adding れば
(tabereba, NOT taberuba)!

Examples: たべる → たべ**れば**, みる → み**れば**,
おきる → おき**れば**, ねる → ね**れば**.
