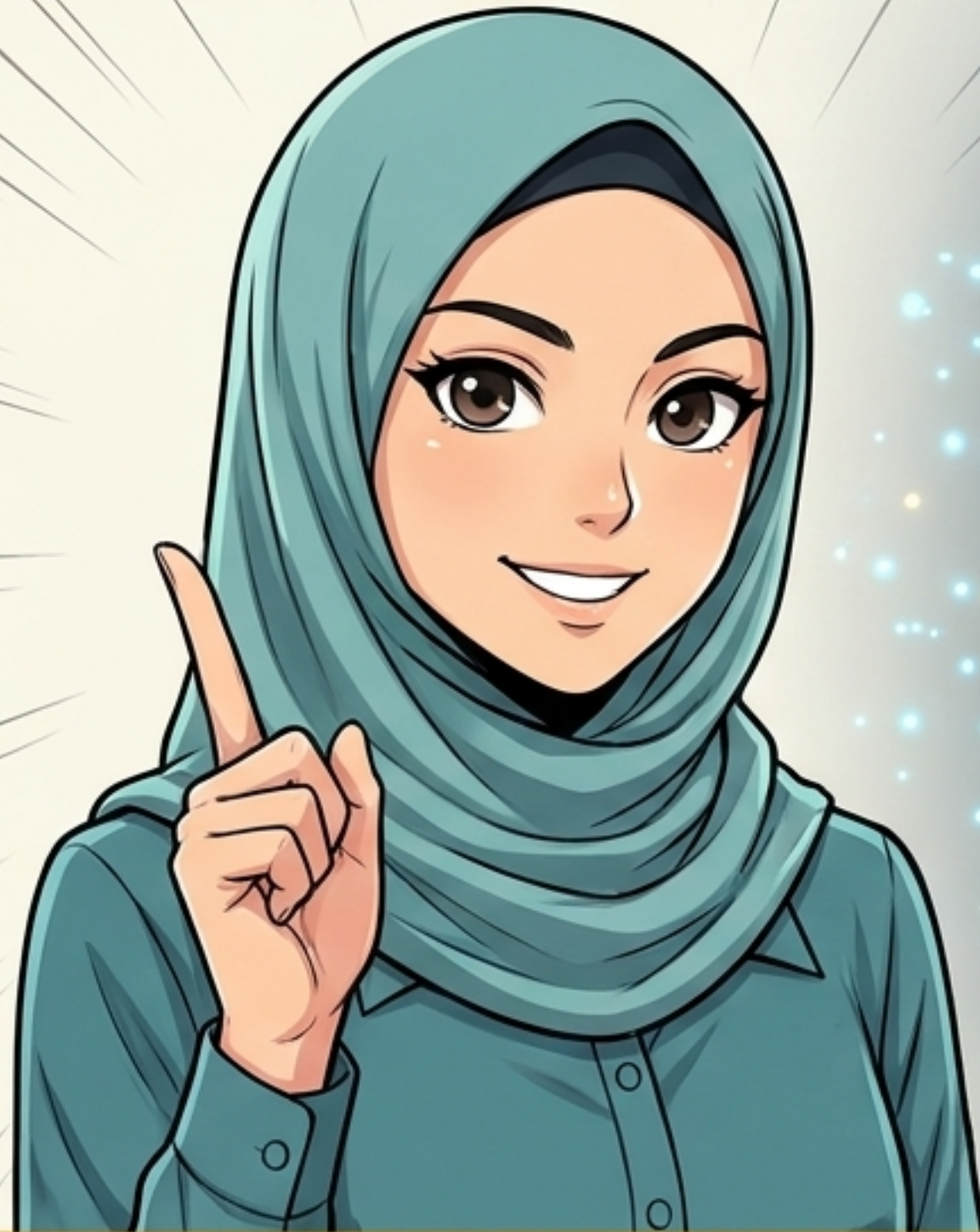

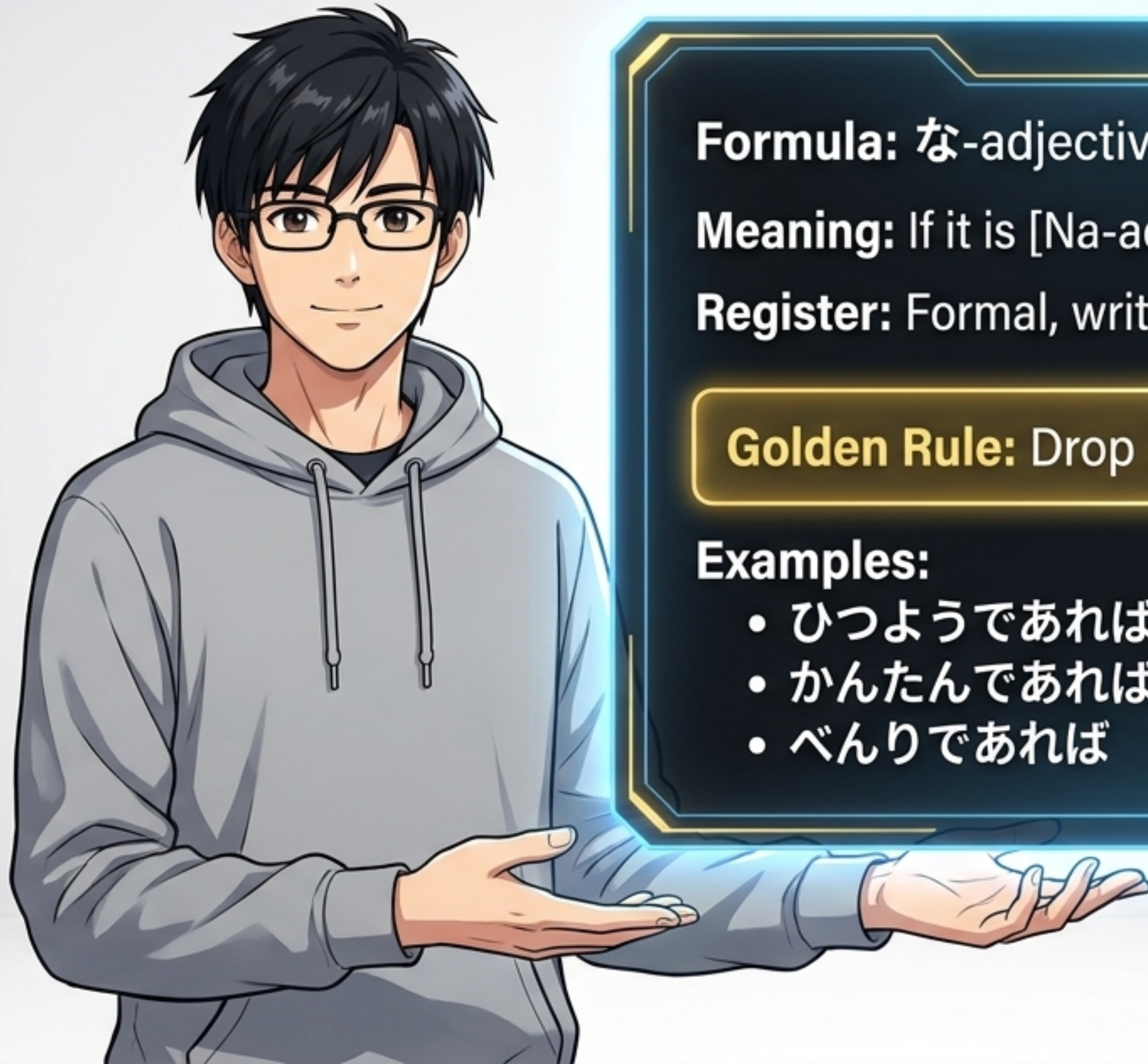

The Formal Condition Cheat Sheet



Formula: な-adjective Base + であれば

Meaning: If it is [Na-adj] / Provided that it is [Na-adj]

Register: Formal, written, official guidelines / business.

Golden Rule: Drop な before adding であれば!

Examples:

- ひつようであれば (If necessary)
- かんたんであれば (If simple)
- べんりであれば (If convenient)
